Because of the above noncompliant items, the law prohibits operation of an establishment without a permit. Operation of an establishment without a permit may lead to civil action to require you to cease operation, or criminal charges in accordance with G.S. 130A-25.

You have a right to a formal appeal of this decision. To pursue a formal appeal, you must file a petition for a contested case hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, 6714 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-6700. To get a copy of a petition form, you may write the Office of Administrative Hearings, visit the website, or call the office at (919) 431-3000. The petition for a contested case hearing must be filed in accordance with the provisions of North Carolina General Statutes 130A-24 and 150B-23 and all other applicable provisions of Chapter 150B.

PLEASE NOTE: If you wish to pursue a formal appeal, you must file the petition form with the Office of Administrative Hearings **WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER.** Meeting the 30-day deadline is critical to your right to a formal appeal. Do not wait for the outcome of any informal review or appeal if you wish to file a formal appeal.

If you file a petition for a contested case hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, you are required by Law (N.C. General Statutes 150B-23) to serve a copy of your petition on the state agency that is a party to the action. The state agency party in this case is the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services. You must send the copy to: Office of General Counsel, N.C. Department of Health and Human Services, 2001 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-2001. Do NOT send the copy of your petition to your local health department. Sending a copy of your petition to the local health department will NOT satisfy the legal requirements in N.C. General Statute 150B-23 that you serve a copy on the state agency that is a party to this action.

	<p>Equipment present in main kitchen area (to exclude serving room and dishroom) has been subjected to splash and aerosolization of hydrochloric acid (Professional's Choice Heavy Duty Acidic Cleaner). Subsequently, the equipment has been further subjected to attempts to clean the acid residue with multiple substances. This has resulted in loss of finish as well as the formation of corrosion. Contamination risk exists due to the presence of residues on food contact surfaces as well as from the drip zones. Surface corrosion re-forms after attempts to clean. 	- Areas of walls uneven, rough, not easily cleanable. Patched areas not repaired with a permanent finish. 6-101.11 Surface Characteristics 6-201.11 Floors, Walls, and Ceilings
