


DETAIL—WATER SERVICE ENTRANCE




DETAIL—WATER HEATER


PLUMBING SUPPLY PLAN BUILDING "1" (OFFICE)




PLUMBING WASTE PLAN BUILDING "1" (OFFICE)


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
A TYPICAL PERIMETER FOUNDATION SECTION


A ALTERNATE PERIMETER FOUNDATION SECTION


B PERIMETER FOUNDATION SECTION


F PERIMETER FOUNDATION SECTION


G CONTINUOUS THICKENED SLAB SECTION

FLOOR PLAN... BUILDING "1"






FLOOR PLAN... BUILDING "2" - SIDE B




A FRAMING ELEVATION SIDEWALL . . . BUILDING "1"
