Dear Sir or Madam:

On May 4, 2020 I made an onsite visit to 36 Tobacco Lane in Dunn, N.C. The purpose of this visit was to make an investigation of the footings for the proposed 52x28 Double wide mobile home at this location. The Harnett County Inspector was concerned about the soil load bearing capacity around perimeter and load bearing piers for the mobile home support. There was some soil material had washed in on the required excavated footing. I was able to check the soil bearing capacity of the footings 6' below the washed material and the soil bearing results exceeded 3000 PSF. However I did recommend that the owner remove a minimum of 6" of the soil below the finished footing sub grade and pour the footings. The NC Regulations For Manufactured Homes 2004 Edition was used for this report. If I can be of any more assistance, please feel free to contact me.
