
Section AV105 Barrier Requirements


ALL GATES SHALL COMPLY w/

Section AV105.2

8. Access gates shall comply with the requirements of <u>Section AV105.2</u>, Items 1 through 7, and shall be equipped to accommodate a locking device. Pedestrian access gates shall open outward away from the pool and shall be self-closing and have a self-latching device. Gates other than pedestrian access gates shall have a self-latching device. The release mechanism of the self-latching device will be located at **54 inches** from the bottom of the gate.



Section AV105 Barrier Requirements

Section AV105.2

- Where a wall of a <u>dwelling</u> serves as part of the barrier, one of the following conditions shall be met:
 - 9.2 Doors with direct access to the pool through that wall shall be equipped with an alarm that produces an audible warning when the door and/or its screen, if present, are opened. The alarm shall be listed and <u>labeled</u> in accordance with UL 2017. The deactivation switch(es) shall be located at least 54 inches above the threshold of the door.
- **NOTE: Doors with pool access will alarmed with the following approved device and will activate within 7 seconds, will be audible for 30 seconds and can be heard throughout the house
