An attempt was made to evaluate your property for the purpose of issuing an Improvement Permit. The evaluation could not be completed for one or more of the following reasons.
1. Use pink flags to mark property lines and irons that are set by surveyor need to be visible. (\$25.00 fee incurred)
2. Use orange flags to mark house corners (\$25.00 fee incurred)
3. Directions not clear to property (\$25.00 fee incurred)
4. Property needs <u>only</u> brush or vegetation removed
5. Driveway not shown on site plan
6. Backhoe pits required
X 7. Other – Proposed soil scientist septic area crosses displayed property line. Proposed upper two lines (red/blue) marked across property line and line 3 (white) marked on property line. Soil Scientist proposal stated property line location was unknown at time of proposal. Only 2 upper property irons located. Advised to have property clearly surveyed including located all irons, marking lines, and marking home location. House box location was not clear. Based on existing unapproved soil scientist proposal lines, available space, and property lines a 4-bedroom DWMH may not be approvable on the property. Ownership and applicant advised with caution on moving forward.
