Seacoast Engineering P.C. recently provided a soil evaluation within the residential manufactured home being set at 70 McKoy Town Road located in Cameron, North Carolina. This letter is the report of our findings and evaluations.

The manufactured home is a 32'x60' double wide and is to be set at 70 McKoy Town Road. There is fill soil on the building pad and the footings are in the fill soil.

Based on the results of our evaluation, the soils and footings are adequate to support the manufactured home and is ready to pour with concrete.

All organic matter, such as tree stumps and root systems, should be removed from all structural areas, such as subgrades for foundations and ground-supported slabs. All disturbed zones left from stump and/or root system removal within structural areas should be properly backfilled and compacted.
