GIS / E911 AddressingRoad Naming Guidelines

- 1. Names will be easy to pronounce, appropriate and not offensive.
- 2. Names having the same or similar pronunciation but with different spellings are not allowed within the county, a municipality, or zip code (e.g., Allen or Alan, Lee or Leigh).
- 3. Use of frivolous or complicated words, or unconventional spellings in road names are not allowed.
- 4. Discriminatory or derogatory names based on race, sex, color, creed, political affiliation or other social factors are not allowed.
- 5. Do not use special characters in road names such as hyphens, apostrophes or dashes.
- 6. Road names being a duplicate of an existing road in Harnett County or in the municipalities surrounding Harnett County are not allowed. (e.g., Pine St and Pine Ln)
- 7. Names are approved based on the road name itself., suffix or road type is not part of the name. See list below.
- 8. Letters and/or initials are not allowed.
- 9. Names for public roads that could be seen as advertising a particular business will not be allowed.
- 10. Road names that could cause copyright or trademark issues are not allowed.
- 11. Full names of famous people shall be avoided.
- 12. Avoid the use of standard suffixes or road types, directional suffixes, or prefixes as part of road names (e.g. North Blvd, Court St, Avenue of Pines).
- 13. Roads within multi-structure complexes should be named and each structure should be addressed individually.
- 14. Directionals and numbers will not be allowed. e.g. West Farm; Ten Oaks
- 15. Double road types are not allowed. e.g. Glen Ridge Dr
- 16. Road names will be no more than 18 characters including spaces and road type abbreviation
