Good morning everyone.

I spoke with Claire yesterday and was told more information was required. As discussed, the builder (Halcyon Homes) has already done most of the work for this space. It's fully framed and no changes will be made. For the loft, we are

installing/finishing the sheetrock, adding a few outlets/lights and installing trim. We will hire someone to install carpet (likely Lowes). For the Bathroom, Halcyion Homes already roughed in plumbing for the shower/bath, vanity and toilet. We will install and finish the space as described in the SOW.

To summarize the documents:

- Building and Trades Permit application we included this in our original submission, please let us know if additional information is required.
- Estimated Costs please note that the LOFT and BATHROOM portion have estimated costs of just over \$13,000. The HVAC portion (already done by Maynor) was just under \$15,000.

Good evening.

In June 2024 we moved to North Carolina and purchased a home from Halcyon Homes with a partially finished third floor. Halcyon did all the structural work (framing, electrical outlets/lights) and even roughed in a bathroom. We are requesting a permit to finish the third floor. We will not be adding additional walls or doorways as this space will be used as a loft (bathroom area is already framed for a door). We've also included a rough drawing with dimensions.

The updates we are requesting a permit for are:

- Adding in HVAC (this was already done my Maynor Service Company (maynorservices.com) in November. We hired them to add heating and AC to the third floor and didn't realize we needed a permit for that. Again, this work is already completed.
- Add additional electrical outlets and lights to the third floor. Currently there are 2 outlets and 3 overhead lights. We would like to add more outlets and add LED lighting. My father-in-law and I planned to do the work ourselves.
- Insulate, sheetrock, finish and paint. Again, we planned to do this ourselves.
- Add carpet (we have not selected the company who will be doing the work yet, but we plan to hire that out)
- As shown in the drawing, the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor already has a bathroom location. Halcyon has already roughed in the bathroom area. We have not decided when we will complete the bathroom, but we imagine it will be a combination of outsourcing some of the work to a plumbing company and doing some work ourselves.

This is our first permit submission in North Carolina so please let us know what else is required to move forward. I can take photos of what the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor currently looks like if that would help.
