Good morning!

Sorry for the delayed answer to the engineers questions concerning the garage bill. Been out of town the last week due to real estate transactions.

1. What is going to be stored on the second floor space of the garage?

The only things that will be stored on the second floor will be my wife's Christmas decorations. These are very light containers ranging from Christmas, easter, July 4th, etc.

2. Access to the second floor will be a stair way = Three rails installed under each step with a hand rail. It will be located in the back of the garage-Approximately 16 steps. No windows will be installed on the second floor since it is for storage only. Electrical lighting will be installed later in the year once the garage is completed and that will require another work permit.

3. Per our plans the walls meeting up with the roof will be 8 feet tall, 16 inches on center. The soffits will extend on the exterior 12 inches. Eventually gutters will be installed later in the year.
