Our church has enclosed part of a pole barn shelter for storage and have added a 3 compartment sink to use to wash large pots and pans. We did not know that we had to get a permit for the drain line from the sink and have installed a 50 gallon grease trap with about 90 feet of drain line for the sink drainage only. (the sink or drain have not been used) There are no bathrooms or other drains going to the grease trap.

I am requesting from you direction on what we need to do to correct the error and next steps to proceed with to get a permit and make sure that everything is to your code.
