The Harnett County Department of Public Health, Environmental Health Division on December 19, 2007, evaluated the above referenced property at the site designated on the plat/site plan that accompanied your existing tank application. According to your application requesting an addition with a 4<sup>th</sup> bedroom, the evaluation was done in accordance with the laws and rules governing wastewater systems in North Carolina General Statute 18A.1950 including related statutes and Title 15A, Subchapter 18A, of the North Carolina Administrative Code, Rule.1950 and related rules.

Based on the criteria set out in Title 15A, Subchapter 18A, of the North Carolina Administrative Code, Rules .1950, the evaluation indicated that the site is UNSUITABLE for the addition requested. Therefore, your request for an existing tank is **DENIED**. The site is denied based on the following:

- 15A NCAC 18A.1950 a(16) Any swimming pool must be 15' from any part of septic system.
- X\_ 15A NCAC 18.1945 (b) Each lot shall have original septic system plus repair area. (Lot was permitted for 3 bedrooms)
- 15A NCAC 18A.1950 (10) Any building to be 5' from drain line.

## Your options are:

- #1 Fill out soil evaluation application at Central Permitting to see if there is enough space to add line and repair for 4th bedroom.
- #2 Add the room without a closet and not use as a bedroom.
