Thank you for submitting the plans for the sprinkler system. The plans have been carefully reviewed by a qualified code enforcement official to examine for full compliance with the North Carolina Fire Prevention Code and all other fire protection regulatory documents. There are some items that were found during the plan review process that need to be addressed before a final inspection of the new facility can be given. These items are outlined and described below.

• 903.3.6 Hose threads.

 Fire hose threads used in connection with automatic sprinkler systems shall comply with NFPA 1963 or as otherwise approved, and shall be compatible with fire department hose threads.

903.4 Sprinkler system monitoring and alarms.

 All valves controlling the water supply for automatic sprinkler systems and water-flow switches on all sprinkler systems shall be electrically supervised





 Alarm, supervisory and trouble signals shall be distinctly different and shall be automatically transmitted to an approved central station, remote supervising station or proprietary supervising station as defined in NFPA 72 or, when approved by the code official, shall sound an audible signal at a constantly attended location

• 903.4.2 Alarms.

O Approved audible devices shall be connected to every automatic sprinkler system. Such sprinkler water-flow alarm devices shall be activated by water flow equivalent to the flow of a single sprinkler of the smallest orifice size installed in the system. Alarm devices shall be provided on the exterior of the building in an approved location. Where a fire alarm system is installed, actuation of the automatic sprinkler system shall actuate the building fire alarm system


• 506.1 When required. KNOX-BOX

Where access to or within a structure or an area is restricted because of secured openings or where immediate access is necessary for life-saving or fire-fighting purposes, the code official is authorized to require a key box to be installed in an accessible location. The key box shall be of an approved type and shall contain keys to gain access as required by the code official.

901.5 Installation acceptance testing.

- Fire detection and alarm systems, fire-extinguishing systems, fire hydrant systems, fire standpipe systems, fire pump systems, private fire service main and all other fire protection systems and appurtenances thereto shall be subject to acceptance tests as contained in the installation standards and as approved by the code official. The code official shall be notified before any required acceptance testing
- o All underground piping shall be tested and inspected prior to tie in.
- o All underground piping shall be flushed and witnessed by our staff.

Thank you for submitting the plans for the new treatment center. The plans have been carefully reviewed by a qualified code enforcement official to examine for full compliance with the North Carolina Fire Prevention Code and all other fire protection regulatory documents. There are some items that were found during the plan review process that need to be addressed before a final inspection of the new facility can be given. These items are outlined and described below.

• 906.1 Fire Extinguishers

o The fire extinguishers provided shall have a minimum rating of 2A 10B:C and shall not be installed higher than 5 feet above the finished floor

• 505.1 Physical Address

- The physical address of the building shall be posted in a conspicuous place so that it can be seen on approach from the road, access road, and/or parking lot.
- o The numbers used to make up the physical address shall be at least 5 inches in height.

• Exit Doors

o All exit doors must unlock upon activation of the fire alarm system to provide for simple ingress and egress of occupants and emergency crews.









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Hood System

- o If the hood system is to remain in the kitchen, the hood system must be inspected and serviced by a reputable company.
- o The hood system must be connected with the fire alarm system.

• Fire Department Access

- o The fire department access shall extend to within 150 feet of all portions of the facility.
- O The fire department access road shall be of an unobstructed width of not less than 20 feet and shall have an unobstructed vertical clearance of not less the 13 feet 6 inches.

• 703.1 Maintenance of Fire Assemblies

- O The required fire-resistance rating of fire-resistance-rated construction (including walls, fire stops, shaft enclosures, partitions and floors) shall be maintained. Such elements shall be properly repaired, restored or replaced when damaged, altered, breached or penetrated. Openings made therein for the passage of pipes, electrical conduit, wires, ducts, air transfer openings, and holes made for any reason shall be protected with approved methods capable of resisting the passage of smoke and fire. Openings through fire-resistance-rated assemblies shall be protected by self-closing or automatic-closing doors of approved construction meeting the fire protection requirements for the assembly
- o Future penetrations to be sealed with some type of removable fire stop.

506.1 Knox Box

- A secure key box shall be installed on the new building that houses all keys to all the doors within the building in which the fire department would need access to in the event of an emergency.
- o A Knox Box will need to be installed on ALL buildings within the complex (7 buildings total).
- Knox Box ID stickers shall be placed on all exterior doors in which entry to the building may be gained.
- o The box shall be mounted not to exceed 48 60 inches in height.
- o The basic model for the buildings should be at least a selection from the 3200 Series listed on the order form.

• Fire/Evacuation Plans

o Fire/Evacuation Plans must be posted in conspicuous locations throughout the building.
