The Harnett County Department of Public Health, Environmental Health Division evaluated the above referenced property at the site designated on the plat/site plan that accompanied your existing tank application. According to your application for an expansion of your system, the evaluation was done in accordance with the laws and rules governing wastewater systems in North Carolina General Statute 18A.1950 including related statutes and Title 15A, Subchapter 18A, of the North Carolina Administrative Code, Rule.1950 and related rules.

Based on the criteria set out in Title 15A, Subchapter 18A, of the North Carolina Administrative Code, Rules .1950, the evaluation indicated that the site is *UNSUITABLE* for the addition requested. Therefore, your request for an existing tank is *DENIED*. The site is denied based on the following:
