Yes, that was intentional on my part. I don't plan on utilizing that part of the yard as a driveway. I plan on directing all traffic to the right side of the house. At the time Oliver visited the site, there was a "construction drive" circling the house. Trucks delivering materials took advantage of the space and inadvertently created a "round about" around the construction site. It was my understanding that this was a requirement only if the drive was to be maintained, just as the suggestion was made that a pump would be required if the water well weren't capped.
