

## Colonial Hills Issue

On Wednesday June 6 Andrew went to check the installation of a new newly permitted septic system on lot 59 Colonial Hills (28 Belmont Ct). The contractor then informed him that he had dug into an existing septic system. Andrew checked the system but had the contractor leave it open until he discussed the issue with me and Jimmy. It was determined that the system that was dug into was from lot 50 (97 Downing Ct) which was permitted and finaled by Joe West on 6/6/07.

On Thursday June 7 I accompanied Andrew out to lot 59 to see if we could use the new system as permitted. It was determined that during installation the old system (lot 50) was excavated and portions removed and will not have a negative effect on the new system for lot 59. The new system was covered up but not finaled. Currently there are two system on lot 59 and the newly installed system cannot be approved until a 20' separation is established between the new system and the old system. Also the old system needs to be relocated completely onto lot 50.

I am writing to you in regards to the waste water system that was initially installed on your lot in 2007. As you are aware, on June 6, 2018 my office discovered that a portion of the drain lines for this system was installed on an adjoining property.

After reviewing the documentation, we contracted with Temple Backhoe Service to perform the repair work on your lot. The original drain lines were disconnected from the tank and portions of the lines were removed at the property line to prevent any flow onto the adjoining property. New drain lines were installed that are totally located with the boundaries of your lot. Both lots now have a separate functioning waste water system.
