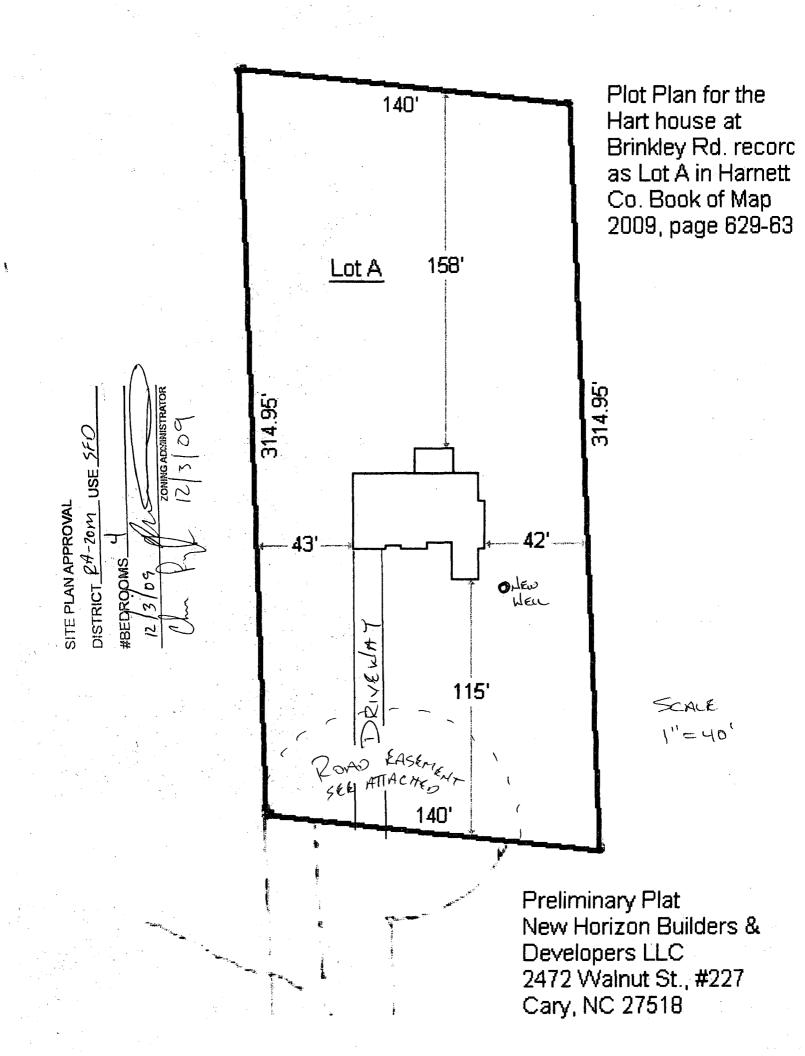

as Seller, upon acceptance of said offer, agrees to sell and convey, all of that plot, piece or parcel of land described below (hereafter referred to as the Property), upon the following terms and conditions:

NOTE: Prior to signing this Vacant Lot Offer to Purchase and Contract, Buyer is advised to review Restrictive Covenants, if any, which may limit the use of the Property, and to read the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants, By-Laws, Articles of Incorporation, Rules and Regulations, and other governing documents of the owners' association and/or the subdivision, if applicable.

2. PURCHASE PRICE: The purchase price is \$18,000 and shall be paid as follows:

(a) SO EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT with this offer by personal check, to be deposited and held in escrow by HJ Morris Construction Co. until the sale is closed, at which time it will be credited to Buyer, or until this contract is otherwise terminated. In the event: (1) this offer is not accepted; or (2) any of the conditions hereto are not satisfied, then all earnest monies shall be returned to Buyer. In the event of breach of this contract by Seller, upon Buyer's request, all earnest monies shall be returned to Buyer, but such return shall not affect any other remedies available to Buyer for such breach. In the event this offer is accepted and Buyer breaches this contract, then all earnest monies shall be forfeited upon Seller's request, but receipt of such forfeited carnest monies shall not affect any other remedies available to Seller for such breach.

After the above letter date, Seller may request in writing from Buyer a copy of the loan commitment letter. If Buyer fails to provide Seller a copy of the loan commitment letter or a written waiver of this loan condition within five days of receipt of Sellers request, Seller may terminate this contract by written notice to Buyer at any time thereafter, provided Seller has not then received a copy of the letter or the waiver.
- (b) There must be no restriction, easement, zoning or other governmental regulation that would prevent the reasonable use of the Property for Residential purposes ("Intended Use")

(e) The Property must be in substantially the same or better condition at Closing as on the date of this offer, reasonable wear and tear excepted.

(d) All deeds of trust, liens and other charges against the Property, not assumed by Buyer, must be paid and satisfied by Seller prior to or at Closing such that cancellation may be promptly obtained following Closing. or install a private septic sewer system as needed.

- 12. SOIL, WATER, UTILITIE'S AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTINGENCY: This contract is contingent upon Buyer obtaining report(s) that (i) the soil is suitable for Buyer's Intended Use, (ii) utilities and water are available to the Property, (iii) there is no environmental contamination, law, rule or regulation that prohibits, restricts or limits Buyer's Intended Use, and (iv) there is no flood hazard that prohibits, restricts or limits Buyer's Intended Use (collectively the 'Reports'). All costs and expenses of obtaining the Reports shall be borne by Buyer Buyer shall use Buyer's best efforts to obtain such Reports. If the Reports cannot be obtained, Buyer may terminate this contract and the Earnest Money Deposit shall be refunded to Buyer. Buyer waives this condition unless Buyer provides written notice to Seller by that this condition cannot be satisfied, time being of the essence.
- 13. RIGHT OF ENTRY, RESTORATION AND INDEMNITY: Buyer and Buyer's agents and contractors shall have the right to enter upon the Property for the purpose of appraising the Property, and performing the tests and inspections permitted in Sections 11, 12 and 13 of this contract. If Buyer terminates this contract as provided herein, Buyer shall, at Buyer's expense, restore the Property to substantially its pre-entry condition within thirty days of contract termination. Buyer will indemnify and hold Seller harmless from all loss, damage, claims, suits or costs, which shall arise out of any contract, agreement, or injury to any person or property as a result of any activities of Buyer and Buyer's agents and contractors relating to the Property. 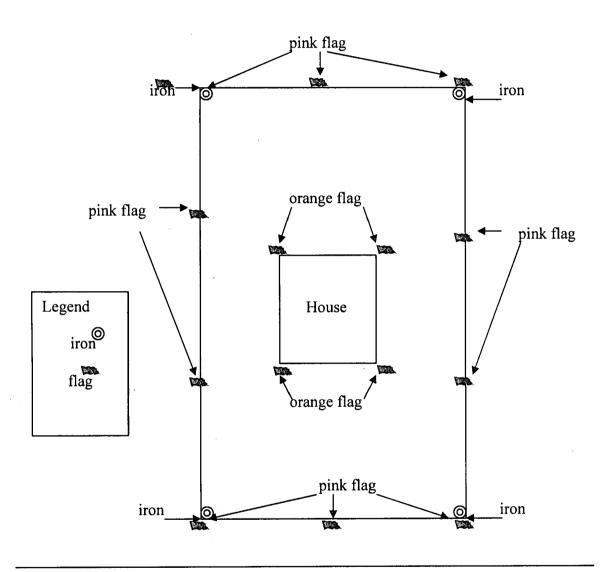

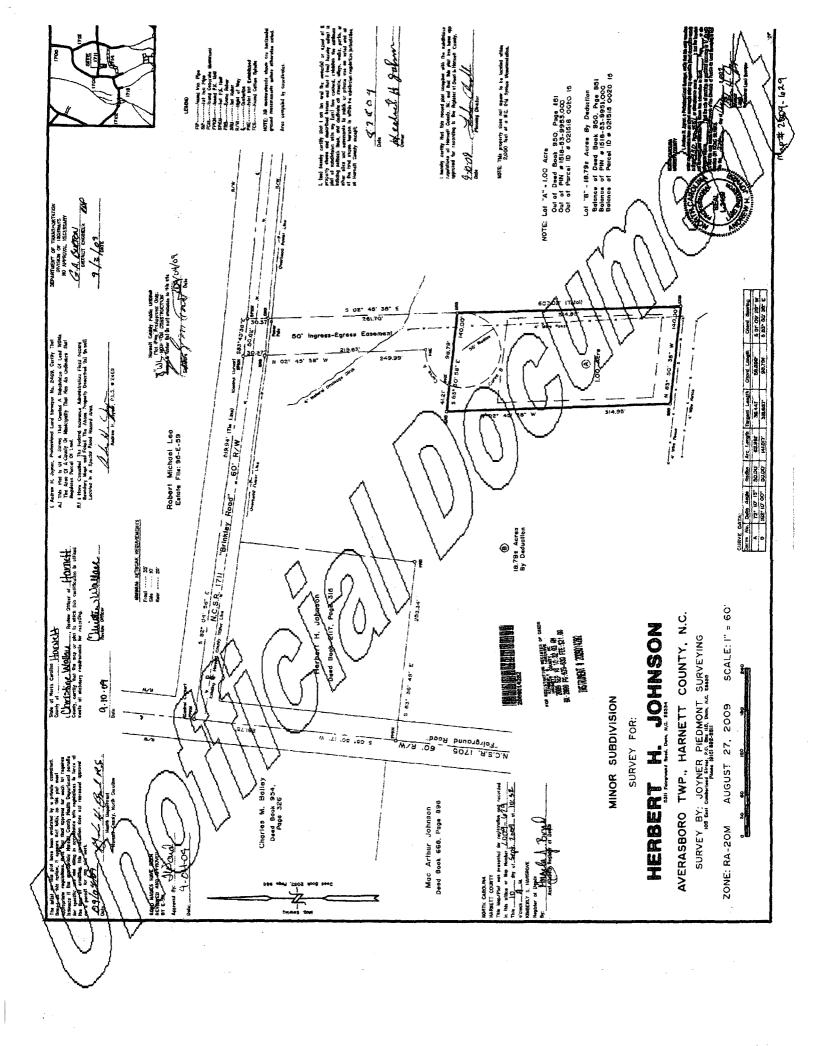
