I suggest that you contact Southeastern Soil & Associates, Inc. to re-evaluate the lot. Once a new proposal is received and verified in the field a new Authorization to Construct may be issued. I suggest for future reference, that the areas for the initial and repair drain fields, be paid close attention to when any lot is cleared.
