ON FEB 15<sup>TH</sup> System WAS INSTALLED BY APLOCK LOCATIONS - NEEDED  
WATER LINE TO BE INSTALLED AS WELL AS power (pump) - I DISCUSSED  
MEASURES TO KEEP REPAIR AREA INTACT AND HOW TO RUN W/L  
IN 2 DIFFERENT AREAS TO ENSURE PROPER PLACEMENT DUE TO SPACE  
MR BRYANT AGREED TO RUN THE WATERLINE IN EITHER OF THE TWO  
WAYS WE DISCUSSED TO AVOID 10' ENCROACHMENT ON DRIVEWAYS AND  
REPAIR AREA. ON 2-18-11 - NOTES - VOICEMAIL AND FILE WERE  
ON MY DESK PERTAINING TO MR BRYANT AND HIS FIRM. HE ALSO  
CAME IN THE OFFICE; ASKED TO SPEAK TO ME + TOLD ME  
THAT WATER LINE WAS IN AND READY FOR FINAL. I  
TOLD HIM THAT I WOULD COME STRAIGHT OUT TO INSPECT.  
9:30 I WENT OUT TO TAKE A LOOK FOR FINAL AND MR BRYANT RAN  
THE WATER LINE IN A MANNER THAT WAS NOT DISCUSSED  
AS ALLOWABLE. THE INSTALL SEEMED TO BE 10' OFF OF DRIVEWAYS  
AND I EXPLAINED WHAT HIS MISTAKE HAD DONE  
AND IT WOULD CHANGE REPAIR AREA AND REQUIRE  
A PUMP TO REPAIR THE SEPTIC BECAUSE OF  
THE PLACEMENT OF THE W/L HE INSTALLED.  
CLIENT WAS INFORMED. W/L AND DITCH  
DISTURBED REPAIR AREA.
