**RE: Notice of Intent to Revoke Improvement Permit #26565  
HTE# 11-5-26514 – Carolina Seasons Lt 111**

To Whom It May Concern,

The Harnett County Department of Public Health inspected the on-site waste water system located at Ponderosa Trail, Lot 111 in Carolina Seasons for compliance with the Laws (Article 11 of Chapter 130A of the North Carolina General Statutes), Rules (15A NCAC 18A .1900 et seq.), and Improvement Permit conditions. As a result of this inspection, the Department has determined the following violations:

***House location not built according to permit in violation of NCGS 130A-335 (e) and (f)  
Rule .1945 (a)***

\*This is to notify you that based on these violations; the Department intends to revoke your Improvement Permit 30 days from the date of this notice. If the Health Department determines that all of the violations have been corrected before thirty (30) days expire, the revocation will not go into effect. If the permit is revoked the Health Department must determine that the violations have been corrected before the revocation will be lifted.

If the permit is revoked, you must apply for a new Improvement Permit and meet the requirements of the current laws and rules necessary to obtain a new permit.

You have a right to an informal review of this decision. You may request an informal review by the Environmental Health supervisor at the local Health Department. You may also request an informal review by the N. C. Department of Environment and Natural Resources regional specialist. A request for informal review must be made in writing to the local Health Department.

You have the right to a formal appeal of this decision by filing a petition for a contested case hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, 6714 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, N.C., 27699-6714.

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To obtain a petition form, you may write the Office of Administrative Hearings, call that office at ph: 910-893-7547 919.431.3000, or download from their website at [www.oah.state.nc.us/hearings](http://www.oah.state.nc.us/hearings). The petition for a contested case hearing must be filed in accordance with the provisions of North Carolina General Statutes 130A-24, 150B-23 and all other applicable provisions of Chapter 150B. N. C. General Statute 130A-335 (g) provides that your hearing would be held in the county where your property is located. fax: 910-893-9371

If you wish to pursue a formal appeal, you must file the petition form with the Office of Administrative Hearings **WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS NOTICE.**

Meeting the 30 day deadline is critical to your right to a formal appeal. Beginning a formal appeal within 30 days will not interfere with any informal review that you may request.


If you file a petition for a contested case with the Office of Administrative Hearings, you are required by law (NCGS 150B-23) to send a copy of your petition to the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Send the copy to: Office of General Counsel, N.C. Department of Environment and Natural Resources, 1601 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-1601. Sending a petition or a copy of the petition to the local Health Department will NOT satisfy the filing requirements of the N.C. General Statutes.

You may call or write the local Health Department if you need additional information or assistance.
