Mr. Holleman,

Thank you for submitting the plans for the storage facility. The plans have been carefully reviewed by a qualified code enforcement official to examine for full compliance with the North Carolina Fire Prevention Code and all other fire protection regulatory documents. There are some items that were found during the plan review process that need to be addressed before a final inspection of the new facility can be given. These items are outlined and described below.

• 906.1 Fire Extinguishers

- Fire extinguishers shall be placed in approved locations as drawn by the code enforcement official on the approved plans.
- The fire extinguishers provided shall have a minimum rating of 2A 10B:C and shall not be installed higher than 5 feet above the finished floor or ground.
- Fire extinguishers shall be installed in such a manner that no distance to an extinguisher is greater than 75', this distance can be measured from existing extinguishers on existing buildings.
- Fire Extinguishers being placed on exterior of the building shall be placed in weather proof closures.
- One 2A 10BC extinguisher shall be placed in the interior corridor of the climate controlled building.

1011.1 Exit / Emergency lights

- Exit lights shall be installed at both entrance doors of Climate Controlled building
- Remote Exit lights shall be installed in corridor of Climate Control building with arrows indicating direction to Exit
- One emergency light needs to be install in the center of the corridor of the Climate Control building

• 505.1 Physical Address (If Phase 2 Buildings have a different address)

- O The physical address of the building shall be posted in a conspicuous place so that it can be seen on approach from the road, access road, and/or parking lot.
- The numbers used to make up the physical address shall be at least 5 inches in height.
- The address shall be posted on the interior of the building indicating the suite location in a conspicuous manner.

Notes

- o If HVAC duct detectors are installed, and acceptance test will be required
- o Please schedule all fire inspections through the Fire marshal's Office.
