I visited your site on May 2, 2018 in response to your application for repair. The water level in the tank was slightly higher than normal but still within the sanitary tee. I probed at least once into each run of the drain line and had excess water only in the top run leaving the tank. In my opinion I think the area around the tree needs to be exposed and checked for roots or a broken step down. Based on the age of your system it is very possible that roots have grown into the drain line and restricted the flow. This work can be done by a licensed septic installer and without a permit. Please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.
