

THIS DEED, Made this the 29th. day of September, 1951 by W. C. Kanoy of Dade County and State of Florida, and his wife, Vertice S. Kanoy of Harnett County, and State of North Carolina, parties of the first part, to THE TRUSTEES OF STEWART'S CHAPEL METHODIST CHURCH, namely: O. M. Leslie, Fred M. Byerly, and Preston Holmes, and their successors in office, all grantees being of Harnett County, State of North Carolina, parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH:

That said W. C. Kanoy and his wife, Vertice S. Kanoy, in consideration of Two Hundred and No. 100 Dollars (\$200.00) to them paid by the aforesaid parties of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to said TRUSTEES OF STEWART'S CHAPEL METHODIST CHURCH: O. M. Leslie, Fred M. Byerly, and Preston Holmes, and their successors in office, a certain tract or parcel of land in Averbosboro Township, Harnett County, State of North Carolina, adjoining the lands of W. C. Kanoy and wife, Vertice S. Kanoy, and more particularly described as follows:

Being one acre of land located approximately one-half mile East of the Mary Stuart School house in Averbosboro Township, Harnett County, State of North Carolina, and on the public road which runs East from said Mary Stuart School premises, and more particularly described by metes and bounds, courses and distances as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a railroad spike in the center line of the aforementioned public road in the Katie McLamb and W. C. Kanoy dividing line, and runs thence from said beginning stake along the said McLamb-Kanoy line North eighteen (18) degrees West a distance of one hundred ninety-one (191) feet to a corner stake; thence a New line North seventy two (72) degrees East a distance of two hundred eighty seven (287) feet to an iron pipe, stake, corner of the one-acre tract; thence South eighteen (18) degrees East a distance of one hundred ninety five and five-tenths (195.5) feet to center of the aforementioned public road; thence with the center line of said road South seventy four (74) degrees and five (.05) minutes West a distance of two hundred forty three and one-tenth (243.1) feet; and South sixty-six (66) degrees and twenty (20) minutes West a distance of forty-four (44) feet to the BEGINNING.

The same being a lot of land one-acre in size exclusive of the road right-of-way on the South side of the tract, and of the fifteen (15) feet drive on the West side of the tract, as shown by survey made by W. L. Corbin on August, 25, 1951 and recorded in Map Book 8 at Page 112, Harnett County Registry. The above described lands were conveyed to grantors by J. W. Thornton and wife Lillian Thornton. See Book 324, Page 364; Harnett County Registry.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD in trust the aforesaid tract or parcel of land, and all privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said TRUSTEES OF THE STEWART'S CHAPEL METHODIST CHURCH, namely: O. M. Leslie, Fred M. Byerly, and Preston Holmes, and their successors in office, to the end that said premises shall be used, kept, and maintained as a place of divine worship of the Methodist ministry and members of the Methodist Church, subject to the Discipline, usage, and ministerial appointments of said church as from time to time authorized and declared by the General Conference and by the Annual Conference within whose bounds the said premises are situated. This provision is solely for the benefit of the grantees, and the grantors reserve no right, title or interest in said premises.

And the said W. C. Kanoy and his wife, Vertice S. Kanoy, for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with said parties of the second part, and their successors in office, that they are seized of said premises in fee and have right to convey in fee simple; that the same are free and clear from all encumbrances, and that they do hereby forever warrant and will forever defend the said title to the same against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
