Abandonment Procedure: Abandonment Procedure: 1. Remove all plumbing or piping into with any obstructions inside the well; 2. Remove as much of the well tile casing a possible, be depth of three feet below land surface; 3. remove all soil or other subsurface material present the remaining well casing, and extending to a width of at least 12 inches outside of the well 4. Using 5 oz. of hypochlorite solution (such as HTH), disinfect the well in accordance with .0111 of this Subchapter. Do not use a common commercial household liquid bleach, as this solution to ensure proper disinfection; 5. Fill the well up to the top of the remaining casing veconcrete grout, bentonite grout, dry clay, or material excavated during drilling of the well an in place; 6. Pour a one foot thick concrete grout or cement grout plug that fills the entire except the top of the casing, including the area extending on all sided of the casing out to a width of on all sides; 7. Complete the abandonment process by filling the remainder of the well above cement plug with additional concrete grout, cement grout, or soil.
