In response to your application, an evaluation or review has been conducted in accordance with the laws and rules governing:

Because of the above noncompliant items, the law prohibits operation of an establishment without a permit. Operation of an establishment without a permit may lead to civil action to require you to cease operation, or criminal charges in accordance with G.S. 130A-25.

You have a right to a formal appeal of this decision. To pursue a formal appeal, you must file a petition for a contested case hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, 6714 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-6700. To get a copy of a petition form, you may write the Office of Administrative Hearings, visit the website, or call the office at (919) 431-3000. The petition for a contested case hearing must be filed in accordance with the provisions of North Carolina General Statutes 130A-24 and 150B-23 and all other applicable provisions of Chapter 150B.

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you wish to pursue a formal appeal, you must file the petition form with the Office of Administrative Hearings **WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER.** Meeting the 30-day deadline is critical to your right to a formal appeal. Do not wait for the outcome of any informal review or appeal if you wish to file a formal appeal.

If you file a petition for a contested case hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, you are required by Law (N.C. General Statutes 150B-23) to serve a copy of your petition on the state agency that is a party to the action. The state agency party in this case is the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services. You must send the copy to: Office of General Counsel, N.C. Department of Health and Human Services, 2001 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-2001. Do NOT send the copy of your petition to your local health department. Sending a copy of your petition to the local health department will NOT satisfy the legal requirements in N.C. General Statute 150B-23 that you serve a copy on the state agency that is a party to this action.

You may call or write the local health department if you need any additional information or assistance.

Dear Mr. King,

A walk through of the Kicking Camel Grill was completed on 6-23-22 per your request. Please see Notice of Permit Denial Form. This serves as the list as noted on the Form.

A permit was not issued due to the following:

- 1- Equipment was not in place and operational. Equipment not in place per site plan.
- 2- Floor was not smooth and sealed. Flooring shall be smooth, no holes or crevices and sealed.
- 3- Coving and trims missing and or not present along wall and floor junctures.
- 4- Gaps present along bar wall shelving and wall. Ledge present along bar wall base trim.
- 5- Gaps present inside liquor storage cabinet.
- 6- Provide flanges to close up openings around pipes entering wall.
- 7- Seal wood on the underside of bar top.
- 8- Treat facility for roaches and provide a contract with a pest control company.
- 9- Mold on walk in cooler walls. Equipment dirty. Clean all equipment, interior and exterior surfaces and cooler walls.
- 10- Residue present on floors and walls. Floors, walls and ceilings need cleaning throughout.
- 11- Gap at back door. Back door must self-close completely.
- 12- Dining room storage cabinet needs painting. Gaps present in cabinet along junctures.

13- No cold water at handsink.

14- Rusty shelving in walk in freezer.

15- Food processor must be NSF/ANSI approved. Hot wells placed as per site plan. Discussed moving hot well to prep table due to breaching on work top freezer.

16- Gaskets torn or not in good repair on reach ins. **Invoice for gaskets provided on 6-24.**
