You have a right to a formal appeal of this decision. To pursue a formal appeal, you must file a petition for a contested case hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, 6714 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-6714. To get a copy of a petition form, you may write the Office of Administrative Hearings or call the office at (919) 431-3000. The petition for a contested case hearing must be filed in accordance with the provisions of North Carolina General Statutes 150A-24 and 150B-23 and all other applicable provisions of Chapter 150B.

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you wish to pursue a formal appeal, you must file the petition form with the Office of Administrative Hearings **WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER.** Meeting the 30-day deadline is critical to your right to a formal appeal. Do not wait for the outcome of any informal review or appeal if you wish to file a formal appeal.

If you file a petition for a contested case hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, you are required by Law (N.C. General Statutes 150B-23) to serve a copy of your petition on the state agency that is a party to the action. The state agency party in this case is the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services. Service must be made in accordance with Rule 4 of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure and 26 NCAC 3-0102(a)(3). You must send the copy to: Office of General Counsel, N.C. Department of Health and Human Services, 2001 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, NC 27699-2001. Do NOT send the copy of your petition to your local health department. Sending a copy of your petition to the local health department will NOT satisfy the legal requirements in N.C. General Statute 150B-23 that you serve a copy on the state agency that is a party to this action.

If you properly file a formal appeal by filing a petition for a contested case hearing in accordance with all statutory requirements prior to the expiration of thirty (30) days, the suspension or revocation shall be stayed pending a final decision by the state agency in the contested case. If you do not either correct the violations or petition for a contested case hearing within thirty (30) days, the suspension shall become effective at the end of thirty (30) days. If suspended, the health department must determine that all of the violations have been corrected before the suspension will be lifted.

You may also request an informal review of this decision in accordance with 15A NCAC 18A-2676. You may call or write the local health department if you need any additional information or assistance.

Soft corn tortilla choice of meat  
with cilantro and onions Salsa (optional)

We order our steak and chicken thru U.S. Foods comes in truck once a week also our vegetables and corn flour comes from U.S. Foods. When truck comes we check and make sure our products are fresh or not damage before we accept them we storage our dry foods in a room temperature storage area, our meats and vegetables are storage in a refrigerator at 36°F

We prep our tacos make to order and serve immediately after prep

## Flautas

Fried rolled chicken tacos serve with lettuce sour cream and cheese salsa (opcional)

Our chicken and vegetables come from U.S. foods. We wash and chop our lettuce, put in a plastic container with cold water and keep in a refrigerator 36° f along with sour cream and cheese

We date our cheese and sour cream 7 days after opening, after our 7 days we discard any product left

We rolled our chicken in a soft corn tortilla and immediately deep fry for 4 minutes or until nice golden, we let drain any excess oil. We serve in a plate with lettuce, sour cream and cheese on top

## Carne azada

tender grill steak serve with rice and beans, and corn tortillas

Our steak, rice and beans comes from V.S. Foods once a week

We use time control in our hot food we cook our beans and rice to a temperature of 135° F or higher for 4 hours after 4 hour we discard.

We cook steak in the grill serve in a plate with rice and beans and serve to order

## Tortas

choice of steak or chicken  
comes with lettuce, tomato, avocado  
and mayonnaise

Our meats and Vegetables comes  
in a truck from U.S. Foods once a week  
along with hoagie bread

Our bread is dated to 7 days after  
delivery and discard any bread left  
after 7 days

We open our hoagie bread littlely toast  
put mayonnaise, meat, lettuce, tomato  
and avocado. make to order

## Burritos

Flour tortilla choice of chicken or steak rice, beans, lettuce sour cream

Our tortillas, meat and all products come from U.S. foods

We warm up a flour tortilla put rice beans, meat, lettuce and sour cream and we wrap into a burrito. make to order

## Chiles rellenos

Poblano peppers stuff with cheese

Our peppers and cheese come from U.S. Foods

We toast our peppers, peel skin and take seed out. stuff them with cheese put a coat of flour then a coat of whipped texture eggs and fry them for 2 minutes on each side

Pollo con tajadas o carne molida  
chicken or ground beef, Plantain

Our meats and produce comes in  
Once a week from U.S. foods  
We check our produce and meats from  
any damage before receive

We wash our chicken in a designated  
sink, from there we put in a container  
with chicken breeder and we cook  
in a pressure cooker at 325° for about  
15 minutes

Our green bananas are wash in a  
sink designated for Vegetables  
we slice and fried for about 5 min  
at 350° all make to order

## Pastelitos (Companadas)

Ground beef Honduran pie stuffed with ground beef, rice and beans

Our corn flour comes from U.S. Foods along with beef

In a bowl we mix corn flour and water to make a soft texture dough, stuff beef inside to make a pie and we fry for about 5 minutes at 350° temperature

We serve with rice and beans  
make to order

## Pupusas (thick flatbread made of corn flour with mozzarella cheese)

In a bowl mix corn flour and water make a soft texture dough mix with cheese cook in a grill for about 4 minutes on each side. make to order

## Enchiladas Hondureñas

Corn tortillas, ground beef, cabbage, cheese, chimol

## Baleada Especial

flour tortilla, steak, beans, sour cream, eggs, avocado

## Baleada tradicional

flour tortilla, eggs, beans, sour cream, cheese

## Baleada sencilla

flour tortilla, beans, cheese, sour cream

Our products come from U.S. foods once a week, we check for any damage before receive

On a flour tortilla we put beans, sour cream, cheese, (opcional) eggs, (opcional) steak fold in half and cook for about 2 minutes on each side
