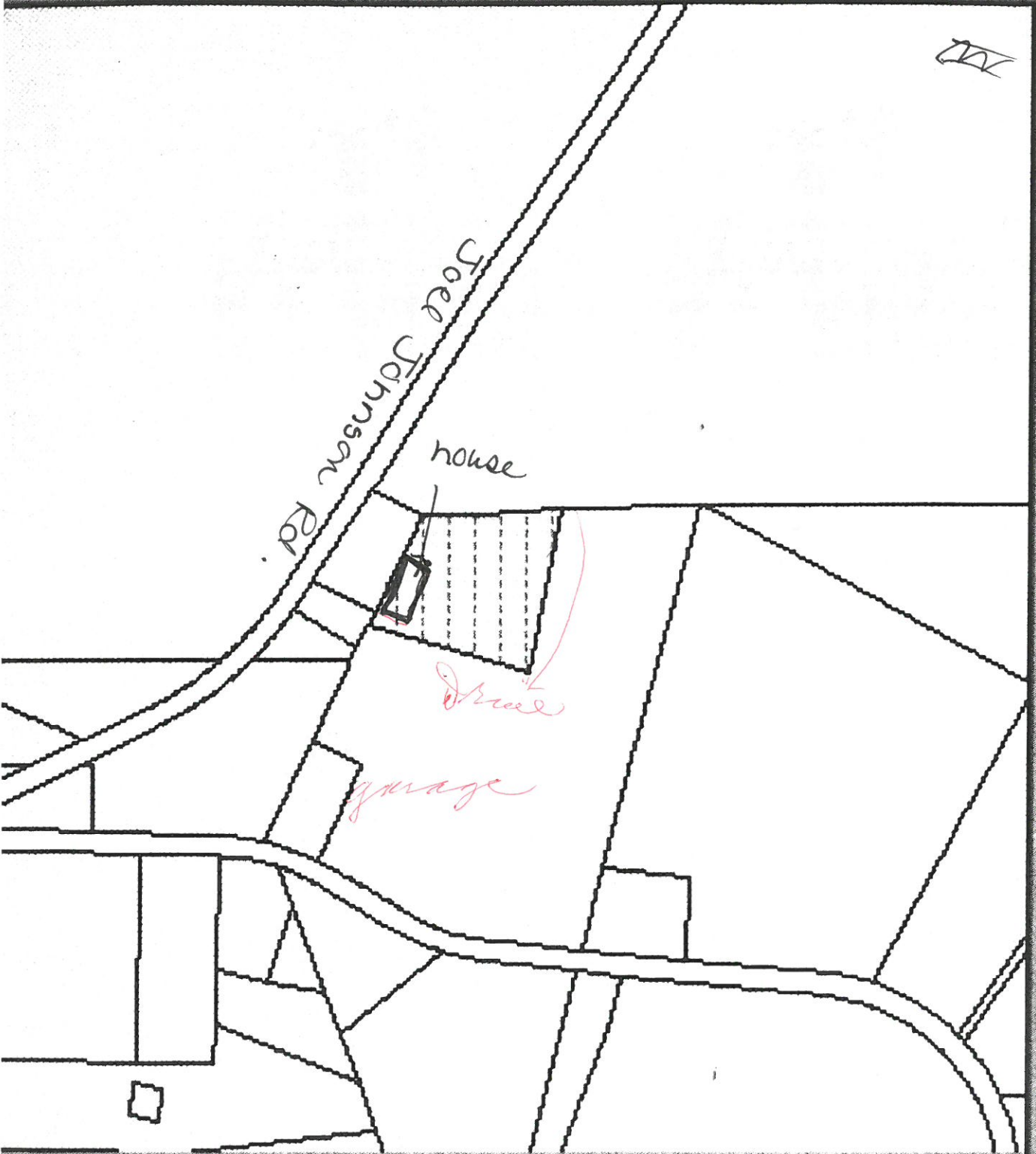

THIS DEED, Made this 3rd day of February, 1978, by and between ISABELL A. BAILEY

_____ of _____ Harnett _____ County
and state of North Carolina, hereinafter called Grantor, and NATHANIEL BAILEY, ELI W. BAILEY and BEATRICE B. HILL

_____ Harnett _____ County and State of North Carolina, hereinafter called Grantee, subject to the Grantor's life estate;

WITNESSETH: That the Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 ----- Dollars and other good and valuable considerations to him in hand paid by the Grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has given, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does give, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the Grantee, his heirs and/or successors and assigns, premises in Lillington Township, Harnett County, North Carolina, described as follows:

All that certain tract or parcel of land containing 33.5 acres, more or less, in Lillington Township, Harnett County, North Carolina, about 2 1/2 miles South of Lillington, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a pine stump with pointers, the beginning corner of 100 acres granted to Neill McLean and a corner of 600 acres, and runs North 62 degrees East 22 chains to a stake corner; thence North 74 degrees West 35 chains to the 7th corner of 100 acres known as the "Folsom corner"; thence as a new marked line South 3 1/2 degrees East 11 chains to a stake corner with pointers; thence as another new marked line South 64 1/2 degrees East 16.50 chains to the beginning, containing 33 1/2 acres, more or less. For further reference see deed dated November 5, 1927 from Ellen J. Bailey, widow, to Walter R. Bailey and wife, Isabella Bailey recorded in Book 226, Page 335, Harnett County Registry.

LESS AND EXCEPT the following three tracts which have been heretofore cut from said tract and conveyed away, to wit:

FIRST TRACT: A tract containing 3.65 acres, more or less, being the southwestern most part of the 33.5 acre tract and more particularly described by a plat and survey made by G. R. Johnson, Surveyor, on November 1, 1956, as follows:

Beginning at a stake, the southwest corner of the 33.5 acre Bailey home place, also Layton and Bell corner, and running thence with the Bailey-Layton line North 1 degree 30 minutes West (old call was North 3 degrees 30 minutes West) 370 feet to a stake; thence a new line South 81 degrees 30 minutes East 483 feet to an iron stake in field; thence another new line South 19 degrees West 498 feet to a stake in the South boundary line of said 33.5 acre Bailey farm, also Bell line; thence with said Bailey-Bell line North 62 degrees 30 minutes West (old bearing was North 64 degrees 30 minutes West) 356 feet to the beginning. Also see plat of the 33.5 acre Bailey farm lands by Russell D. Boseman, Registered Surveyor, dated July 17, 1933. For further reference see deed dated November 4, 1958 from Walter R. Bailey and wife to Beatrice B. Hill recorded at Book 387, Page 107, Harnett County Registry.

SECOND TRACT: A tract of land containing 1.23 acres, more or less, being the southeastern most part of the 33.5 acre tract and more particularly described by a plat and survey made by G. R. Johnson, Surveyor, November 14, 1961, as follows:

Beginning at an iron stake on the southeast side of Bell public road and running thence North 62 degrees 30 minutes West with Bell-Bailey line 363 feet to an iron stake; thence a new line North 33 degrees 30 minutes East 153.5 feet to an iron stake; thence another new line South 64 degrees 30 minutes East 295.5 feet to an iron stake on the West side of Bell public road; thence South 9 degrees West 170 feet to the Beginning. For further reference see deed dated March 29, 1962 from Walter R. Bailey and wife to Eli Bailey and wife, Geraldine Bailey recorded in Book 415, Page 111, Harnett County Registry.

THIRD TRACT: A tract of land containing 2.20 acres, more or less, more particularly described by a plat made by Walter Lee Johnson on April 2, 1965 as follows:

Beginning at an iron stake in the southeast margin of State topsoil Road #2035, said point being North 70 degrees 40 minutes East 28 feet from the center of said road; thence with the Nathan McCormick line North 70 degrees 40 minutes East 550.5 feet to an iron stake; thence North 39 degrees West 373.5 feet to an iron stake in the Eastern margin of topsoil Road #2035; thence with said road South 32 degrees 10 minutes West 432 feet to an iron stake; thence South 23 degrees 45 minutes West 123 feet to the point of Beginning.
