2. The outlet end of the tank and distribution box will need to be uncovered and property lines marked. After the tank is uncovered, property lines are marked and orange sign has been placed, you will need to call us at 893-7547 or 893-7548 to let us know that it is ready.
3. The system must be repaired within 30 days or the set time within receipt of a violation letter.

This certifies that all of the above information is correct to the best of my knowledge. False information will result in the denial of the permit. The permit is subject to revocation if the site plan, intended use, or ownership change.

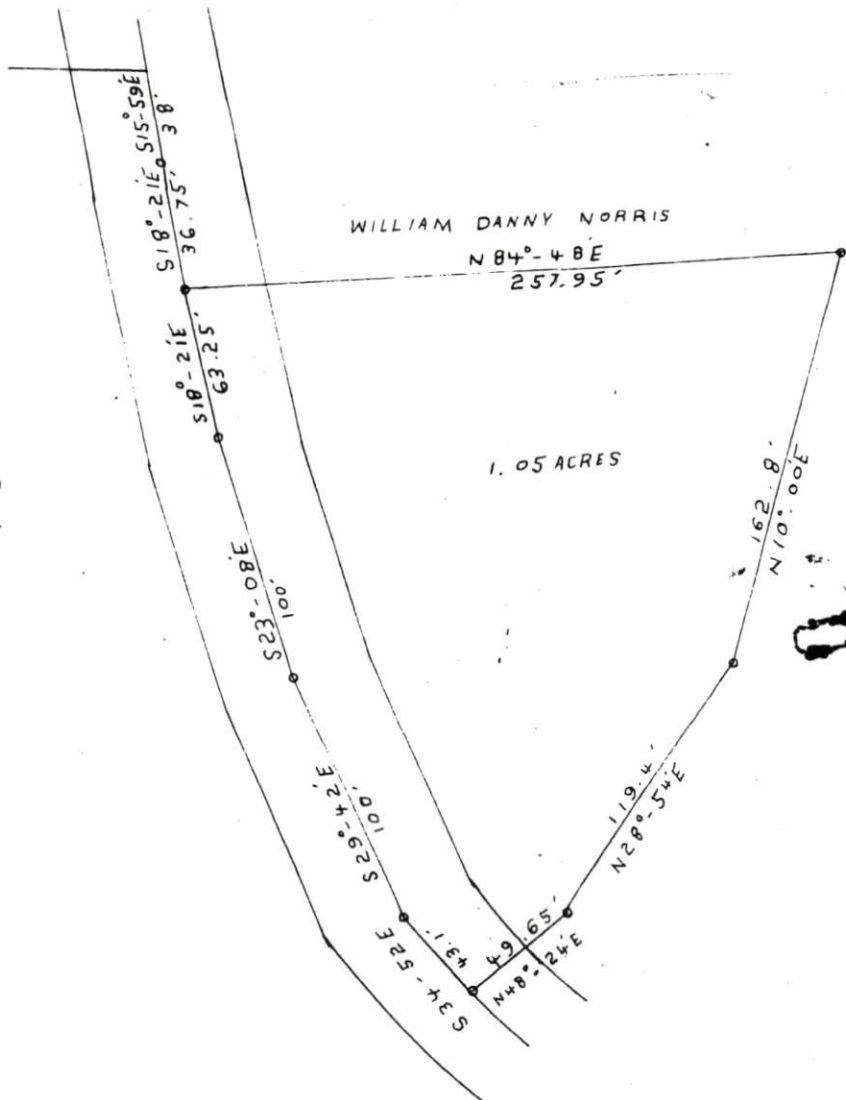

THIS DEED, Made this 1st day of April, 1977, by and between EDGAR NORRIS, JR. and wife, LOTTIE NORRIS of Harnett

and state of North Carolina, hereinafter called Grantor, and BONNIE LOU WEST of Harnett County and State of North Carolina, hereinafter called Grantee, whose permanent mailing address is Route #1, Benson, N. C.

WITNESSETH: That the Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of TEN AND NO/100 Dollars and other good and valuable considerations to him in hand paid by the Grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed, confirmed, warranted, assigned, transferred, and in anywise disposed of, and by these presents does give, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the Grantee, his heirs and/or successors and assigns, premises Grove Township, Harnett County, North Carolina, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a nail in the center of the road, SR #1551, said nail being located 74.75 feet measured as the center of the road in a southward direction from the NE corner of the tract sold by Edgar Norris to Stanley Smith and runs as the center of the road the following courses and distances: South 18 degrees 21 minutes East 63.25 feet; South 23 degrees 08 minutes East 100 feet; South 29 degrees 42 minutes East 100 feet, and South 34 degrees 52 minutes East 43.1 feet to a point in the center of the road; thence leaving the road North 48 degrees 24 minutes East 49.65 feet to an iron stake on the pond dam; thence North 28 degrees 54 minutes East 119.4 feet to a stake at the edge of the pond; thence North 10 degrees East 162.8 feet to an iron stake at the edge of the pond; thence South 84 degrees 48 minutes West 257.95 feet to the point of beginning, and contains 1.05 acres, more or less.

The above property being a portion of that land described in deed of Edgar Norris, Jr. to Lottie H. Norris, dated January 7, 1972, and recorded in Book 567, Page 166, Harnett County Registry.

The above land was conveyed to Grantor by _____ See Book No. _____ Page _____ TO HAVE AND TO HOLD The above described premises, with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, unto the Grantee, his heirs and/or successors and assigns forever.

And the Grantor covenants that he is seized of said premises in fee, and has the right to convey the same in fee simple; that said premises are free from all encumbrances (with the exceptions above stated, if any); and that he will warrant and defend the said title to the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

When reference is made to the Grantor or Grantee, the singular shall include the plural and the masculine shall include the feminine or the female. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, The Grantor has hereunto set his hand and seal, the day and year first above written.

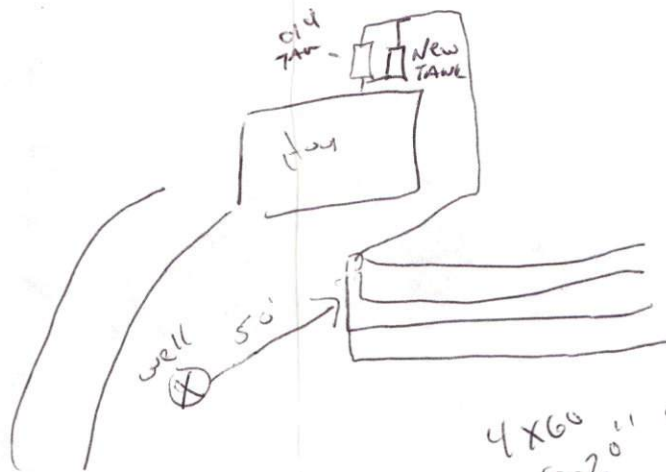
