2. The outlet end of the tank and distribution box will need to be uncovered and property lines marked. After the tank is uncovered, property lines are marked and orange sign has been placed, you will need to call us at 893-7547 or 893-7548 to let us know that it is ready.
3. The system must be repaired within 30 days or the set time within receipt of a violation letter.

This certifies that all of the above information is correct to the best of my knowledge. False information will result in the denial of the permit. The permit is subject to revocation if the site plan, intended use, or ownership change.

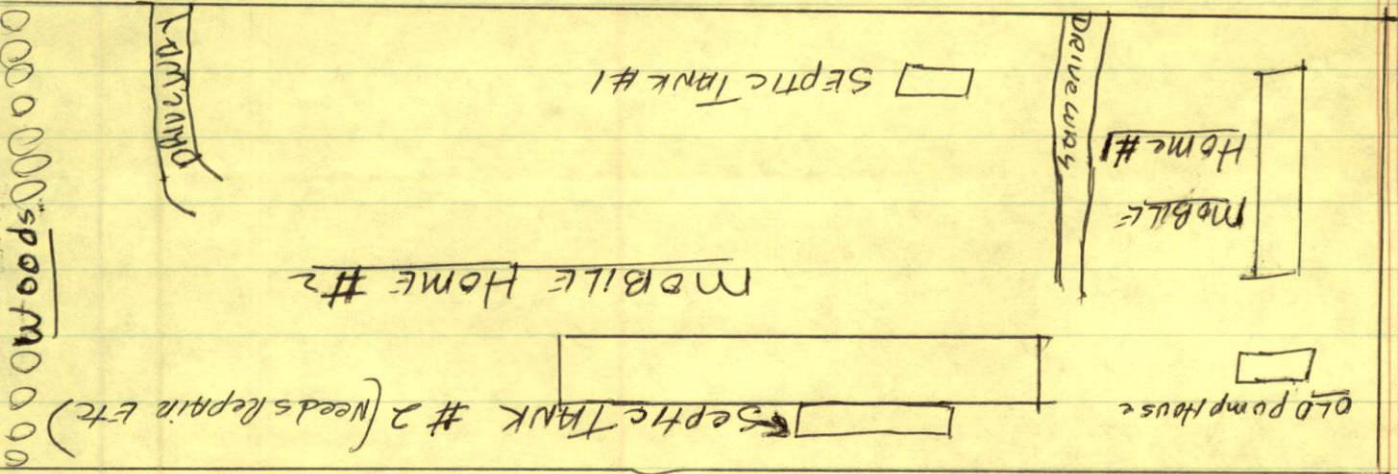

THIS DEED, made this 30 day of Dec. 1959, by

Rufus L. Mangum and wife, Mavie M. Mangum, Grantors,

To Hazel M. Stephenson, Grantees, all of

Harnett County, North Carolina; Witnesseth: That the Grantors, in consideration of Ten Dollars and other valuable considerations to them paid by the Grantees, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Grantees, their heirs, or successors, and assigns, the parcel(s) of land in Harnett County, North Carolina, in Neill's Creek Township, adjoining the lands of

Rufus Mangum and others, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at that point where northern boundary line of the 67 acre tract intersects the northwestern property line of the state improved road, 30 feet from the center of said road or highway, and runs thence with said original boundary line N. 43 deg. 15' W. 150 feet to a corner in said line; thence S. 54 deg. 45' W. 200 feet to a corner; thence S 43 deg. 15' E. parallel with the first call, 150 feet to a corner in the northwestern property line of the state improved road or highway; thence with said northwest line of said state improved road or highway N. 54 deg. 45' E. 200 feet to the beginning station, and is .68 acre, more or less.

This property was conveyed to Grantors by deed dated 11-19-46 recorded in Book 302 Page 408 Harnett County Registry.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid parcel(s) of land all privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Grantees, their heirs, or successors, and assigns forever.

And the said Rufus L. Mangum and wife, Mavie M. Mangum Grantor(s), for themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators; covenant with the Grantees, their heirs, or successors, and assigns that they are seized of said premises in fee and have the right to convey the same in fee simple; that the same are free from encumbrances except as herein set forth; and that they will warrant and defend the said title to the same against the claims of all persons whomsoever. The plural number as used herein shall equally include the singular. The masculine or feminine gender as used herein shall equally include the neuter.
