Dear Mr. & Mrs. Evans:

I represent the Harnett County Department of Public Health ("Health Department"). The Health Department performed an on-site inspection of the above-mentioned property on March 16, 2016 and observed a failing septic system. It is my understanding that this is a complaint that dates back to June 26, 2014. It is imperative that this matter be resolved immediately.

The current condition of your property is in violation of the Rules and Regulations adopted by the North Carolina Commission for Health Services, found at 15A NCAC 18A.1961 of the North Carolina Administrative Code, and adopted in accordance with §130A-335 (a) of the North Carolina General Statutes. This law provides that any person owning or controlling a residence, place of business, or place of public assembly containing water-using fixtures connected to a water supply source shall discharge all wastewater directly to an approved wastewater system permitted for that specific use. A wastewater system may include components for collection, treatment, and disposal of wastewater.

This problem *must* be corrected, and the waste properly disposed of within 14 days of the date of this correspondence. It is important that action be taken to remedy this public health nuisance immediately. If we do not hear from you within seven days from the date of this correspondence regarding your plan to abate this public health nuisance, we will assume that you do not wish to resolve this matter amicably and will have no choice but to pursue all appropriate legal measures to abate this public health nuisance, to and including filing suit against you.
