After the tank is uncovered, property lines are marked and orange sign has been placed, you will need to call us at 910-893-7547 to let Environmental Health know that your site is ready for evaluation.
  3. The system must be repaired within 30 days or the time set within receipt of a violation letter.

By signing below, I certify that all of the above information is correct to the best of my knowledge. False information will result in the denial of the permit. The permit is subject to revocation if the site plan, intended use, or ownership change.

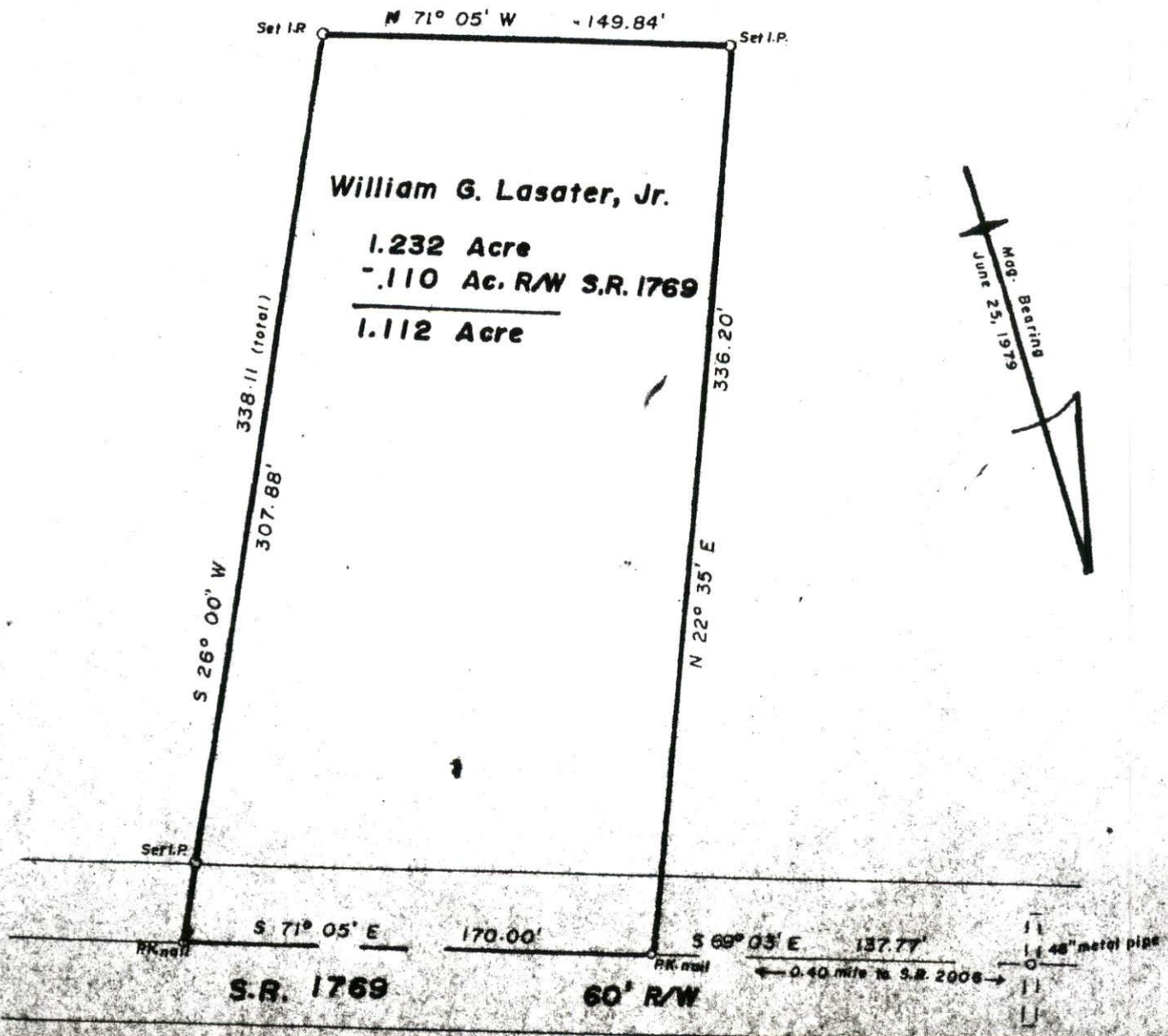

THIS DEED made this 29th day of June, 1979, by and between

The designation Grantor and Grantee as used herein shall include said parties, their heirs, successors, and assigns, and shall include singular, plural, masculine, feminine or neuter as required by context.

WITNESSETH, that the Grantor, for a valuable consideration paid by the Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Grantee in fee simple, all that certain lot or parcel of land situated in Grove Township, Harnett County, North Carolina and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a nail located in the center of the right-of-way of S. R. 1769 at a point South 69 degrees 03 minutes East 137.77 feet from the center of a 48 inch metal pipe running under said road and being approximately 0.40 mile from the intersection of said road with S. R. 2006 and runs thence as the center line of said S. R. 1769 South 71 degrees 05 minutes East 170.00 feet to another nail located in the center of the right-of-way of the said S. R. 1769; thence a new line South 26 degrees 00 minutes West 338.11 feet to a set iron pipe; thence another new line North 71 degrees 05 minutes West 149.84 feet to another set iron pipe; thence another new line North 22 degrees 35 minutes East 336.20 feet to the point of Beginning and containing 1.232 acres, according to survey and plat of Piedmont Surveying, Dunn, N. C., dated June 17, 1979, entitled "Property of William G. Lasater, Jr."
