The single-wide mobile home is being demolished. The electrical service should be terminated into a meter and lockable panel box on the outside of the building. It shall be ran inside for water heater and lights. Plumbing shall be for small bathroom in recreational building. It shall be winterized for cold weather. By observation and study of the damage site, I have determined that the structure roof should have a new treated 2x4 bottom chord from wall to wall. It should have diagonal bracing to the existing bottom chord. With this the building will carry the wind and gravity loads pursuant to the NCRC.
