Subject: Roof Truss Repair

Mr. Tallent,


At your request, I reviewed the home at the subject address. Specifically, I reviewed the damaged roof trusses and a method for repair/replacement.

Based on my review and analysis of the damaged single wide mobile home roof, I recommend replacing the existing roof trusses with a stick framed roof. It consists of 2x6 rafters (approx.. 3:12 pitch) with a 2x8 ridge plate. A 2x6 ceiling joist should be used to tie the walls together creating a flat ceiling. If desired, the ceiling joist may be raised up to 8 inches to create a "trey" ceiling effect, but a 2x6 should still be used as a ceiling joist. Also, 2x4 "webs" should be added at 1/3 of the width of the rafter section to tie the rafter to the ceiling joist. See the attached sketch for illustration.
