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Mr. Gregory,

Thank you for submitting the plans for Carolina Signs and Service. The plans have been carefully reviewed by a qualified code enforcement official to examine for full compliance with the North Carolina Fire Prevention Code and all other fire protection regulatory documents. There are some items that were found during the plan review process that need to be addressed before a final inspection of the new facility can be given. These items are outlined and described below.

- **906.1 Fire Extinguishers**

- Fire extinguishers shall be placed in approved locations as drawn by the code enforcement official on the approved plans.
- The fire extinguishers provided shall have a minimum rating of 2A 10B: C and shall not be installed higher than 5 feet above the finished floor.
- Fire extinguishers shall be serviced and tagged on a yearly basis by an authorized company.

- **505.1 Physical Address**

- The physical address of the building shall be posted in a conspicuous place so that it can be seen on approach from the road, access road, and/or parking lot.
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- The numbers used to make up the physical address shall be at least 5 inches in height.
- Also, place 5 inch address numbers on the rear doors of a multi-tenant building.
- **901.5 Acceptance Test Required**
 - The duct smoke detection system shall be subject to an acceptance test by the installing mechanical contractor and witnessed by the fire marshal's office staff before final approval for occupancy of the space.
- **907.4.1 Duct smoke detectors**
 - Activation of a duct smoke detector shall initiate a visible and audible supervisory signal at a constantly attended location and shall perform the intended fire safety function in accordance with the Mechanical Code.
- **506.1 Knox Key Box**
 - A Knox Key box must be installed on at or near the main entrance door to the building. The order form and information is provided. Once construction is complete, a key(s) must be locked inside for Fire Department access during after-hours emergencies.

Thank you again for submitting the plans for the Carolina Signs and Service. Please review the plans and adhere to any notes and alterations that were made in addition to the original drawings. These remarks are for the plans that were submitted and its original intent. These remarks do not apply if the original intent changes or what was submitted on the above date changes.
