A preliminary soils evaluation was completed on the above referenced property on March 30, 2009. The purpose of the evaluation was to determine the ability of the soils to support a subsurface waste disposal system for a three bedroom mobile home. All ratings and determinations were made in accordance with "Laws and Rules for Sewage Treatment and Disposal Systems, 15A NCAC 18A .1900".

The tract was evaluated by auger borings and landscape position. The typical soils were a sandy loam over sandy clay loam or sandy clay to twenty-four or more inches. Soils were limited by shallow depths to soil wetness and expansive clays. Areas of provisionally suitable soil were located and are shown on the enclosed sketch. These area are marked on site by double blue flagging. These soils would require a long term acceptance rate of .3 gpd/sqft. Due to the limited area, the initial system would be an accepted 25% reduction system and the repair would likely be a low pressure pipe system. The initial system would be installed at twelve inches deep requiring six or more inches of cover. An interceptor drain is also needed above and along the sides of the initial system. Due to recent rainfalls, a ditch may be needed twenty-five or more feet below the proposed initial system area to aid in the installation.
