Dear Sirs,

On May 17, 2011, the On-site Water Protection Section received a request to case a well less than 20 in depth in accordance with 15A NCAC 2C .0116(c) and also made a site visit. The approval request is for the construction of one water supply well at 454 Ball Park Lane, Erwin, NC. The request indicated sufficient water of acceptable quality is not available to a minimum depth of 50 feet in accordance with 15A NCAC 2C .0116(c)(1).

Based upon available information, you are approved to construct a well in the area indicated at the above referenced site which is 273 feet from the septic system. The well shall be cased and grouted to the maximum depth feasible but in no case shall the well be cased less than 10 feet. The previous 54 foot deep uncased test well on the property must be abandoned in accordance with 15A NCAC 2C .0113.

The granting of this approval is for allowing the well to be cased less than 20 feet, and in no way relieves the owner or agent from other requirements of the North Carolina Well Construction Standards, or any other applicable law, rule, or regulation that may be regulated by other agencies; nor does it imply sufficient water quality or quantity.

In accordance with 15A NCAC 2C .0107(b)(4) wells cased less than 35 feet in depth based on lot size or fixed conditions are covered under the provisions in 15A NCAC 2C.0116(c). In accordance with 15A NCAC 2C .0116(c)(1) sufficient water of acceptable quality for the intended use can be shown, to the satisfaction of the Department (the Division of Environmental Health) that it is not available to a minimum depth of 50 feet.
