

Last Will and Testament

OF

I, Billy Bayles, domiciled in Harnett County, North Carolina, declare this to be my last will, hereby revoking all wills and codicils heretofore made by me. This will consists of three (3) pages.

PREAMBLE

I commit myself to God's care, secure in His love for me and trusting in the salvation purchased for me through Christ's suffering and death. I leave those who survive me the comfort of knowing that I have died in this faith and have now joined my Lord in eternal glory.

I commend my loved ones to the protecting arm of God, knowing that He will continue to provide for them despite my absence; and I encourage them to place their faith and trust in Him alone.

ARTICLE I.

I direct that all of my just debts, my funeral expenses, including the cost of a suitable monument at my grave, and the cost of administration of my estate be paid out of the assets of my estate as soon as practicable after my death.

ARTICLE II.

I direct that all estate and inheritance taxes and any other taxes in the general nature thereof, which shall become payable upon or by reason of my death, shall be paid by my Executor/rix out of the assets of my estate as soon as practicable after my death.

ARTICLE III.

Real Property. I will, devise, and bequeath in fee simple any real property, wherever the same may be located, to my nephew, Lewis Charles Bayles, Jr.

Personal Property. I give and bequeath the residue of my personal property, tangible or intangible, of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated, in fee to my nephew, Lewis Charles Bayles, Jr.

I may leave a writing which, although not a part of my will, expresses my desires concerning the disposition of my tangible personal property. I request, but not require, that my wishes be observed if such a list shall be found with this Will.

ARTICLE IV.

conditions as he or she may see fit, and to do every other act and thing necessary or appropriate for the complete administration of my estate. Without in any way limiting the generality of the foregoing provision, I hereby grant my Executor/rix or substitute Executor/rix all of the powers set forth in North Carolina G.S. § 32-27, subject to § 32-26, and these powers are expressly incorporated by reference.

ARTICLE V.


If any beneficiary under this will and I should die under such circumstances that there is uncertainty as to which person predeceased the other, or if the date of death occurs within thirty days of one another, it shall be conclusively presumed for the purposes of this will that such beneficiary predeceased me.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I sign, seal, publish, and declare this instrument to be my Last Will this 23rd day of March, 2016.



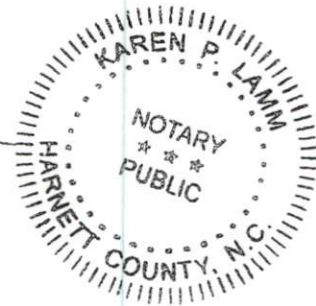
