

On the attached sketch I have highlighted unsuitable soil areas for septic (after completing a lot by lot field review).

As recorded on the attached sketch, lots 103, 105 - 108, 109 - 116, 121 - 125, 133 - 136, 147 & 148 will work for at least a 3Br septic. Many would be 4Br.

Lots 102, 117 & 120 are unsuitable. We checked 102, 103 & 105 - 108 to locate soils in case you redesign anything. If so, please provide a revised map. I will withhold any needed reports until construction is complete and a final site review is completed.
