Dear Mr. Galvin,

Thank you for using Piedmont Geotechnical. The site was visited on July 25, 2022 to test the subgrade for the exposed footing excavations at the above referenced home site. The subgrade was tested with a Dynamic Cone Penetrometer (DCP) test in general accordance with (ASTM) special publication 399, and found to be of inadequate bearing capacity. The footing excavation bottoms were probed with a steel probed rod for comparison to the test locations.

The test results indicated that the tan silty sands to clayey sands were of inadequate bearing at the existing excavation bottoms at about 3 to 5 feet below the surrounding grade, approximately 2 to 3 feet along the right and approximately 1 to 2 feet along the right below the existing bearing level.

Based on testing, The loose soils should be over excavated and re-tested to determine the remedial repairs (possible filter fabric and washed stone placement to the planned footing bearing level) of the home.
