### **ROOF VENTILATION**

**R806.1 Ventilation required.** Enclosed *attics* and enclosed rafter spaces formed where ceilings are applied directly to the underside of roof rafters shall have cross ventilation for each separate space by ventilating openings protected against the entrance of rain or snow. Ventilation openings shall have a least dimension of 1/16 inch (1.6 mm) minimum and 1/4 inch (6.4 mm) maximum. Ventilation openings having a least dimension larger than 1/4 inch (6.4 mm) shall be provided with corrosion-resistant wire cloth screening, hardware doth, or similar material with openings having a least dimension of 1/16 inch (1.6 mm) minimum and 1/4 inch (6.4 mm) maximum. Openings in roof framing members shall conform to the requirements of Section R802.7.

**R806.2 Minimum area.** The total net free ventilating area shall not be less than 1/150 of the area of the space ventilated except that reduction of the total area to 1/300 is permitted provided that at least 50 percent and not more than 80 percent of the required ventilating area is provided by ventilators located in the upper portion of the space to be ventilated at least 3 feet (914 mm) above the eave or cornice vents with the balance of the required ventilation provided by eave or cornice vents. As an alternative, the net free cross-ventilation area may be reduced to 1/300 when a Class I or II vapor retarder is installed on the warm-in-winter side of the ceiling.

- 1. Enclosed attic/rafter spaces requiring less than 1 square foot (0.0929 m2) of ventilation may be vented with continuous soffit ventilation only.
- 2. Enclosed attic/rafter spaces over unconditioned space may be vented with continuous soffit vent only.

## **GUARD RAIL NOTES**

### **SECTION R312**

R312.1 Where required. Guards shall be located along open-sided walking surfaces, including stairs, ramps and landings, that are located more than 30 inches (762 mm) measured vertically to the floor or grade below at any point within 36 inches (914 mm) horizontally to the edge of the open side. Insect screening shall not be considered as a *guard*.

**R312.2 Height.** Required *guards* at open-sided walking surfaces, including stairs, porches, balconies or landings, shall be not less than 36 inches (914 mm) high measured vertically above the adjacent walking surface, adjacent fixed seating or the line connecting the leading edges of the treads. Exceptions:

- 1. Guards on the open sides of stairs shall have a height not less than 34 inches (864 mm) measured vertically from a line connecting the leading edges of the
- 2. Where the top of the *guard* also serves as a handrail on the open sides of stairs, the top of the *guard* shall not be not less than 34 inches (864 mm) and not more than 38 inches (965 mm) measured vertically from a line connecting the leading edges of the treads.

**R312.3 Opening limitations.** Required *guards* shall not have openings from the walking surface to the required *guard* height which allow passage of a sphere 4 inches (102 mm)in diameter. Exceptions:

- 1. The triangular openings at the open side of a stair, formed by the riser, tread and bottom rail of a *guard*, shall not allow passage of a sphere 6 inches (153 mm) in diameter.
- 2. *Guards* on the open sides of stairs shall not have openings which allow passage of a sphere 43/8 inches (111 mm) in diameter.

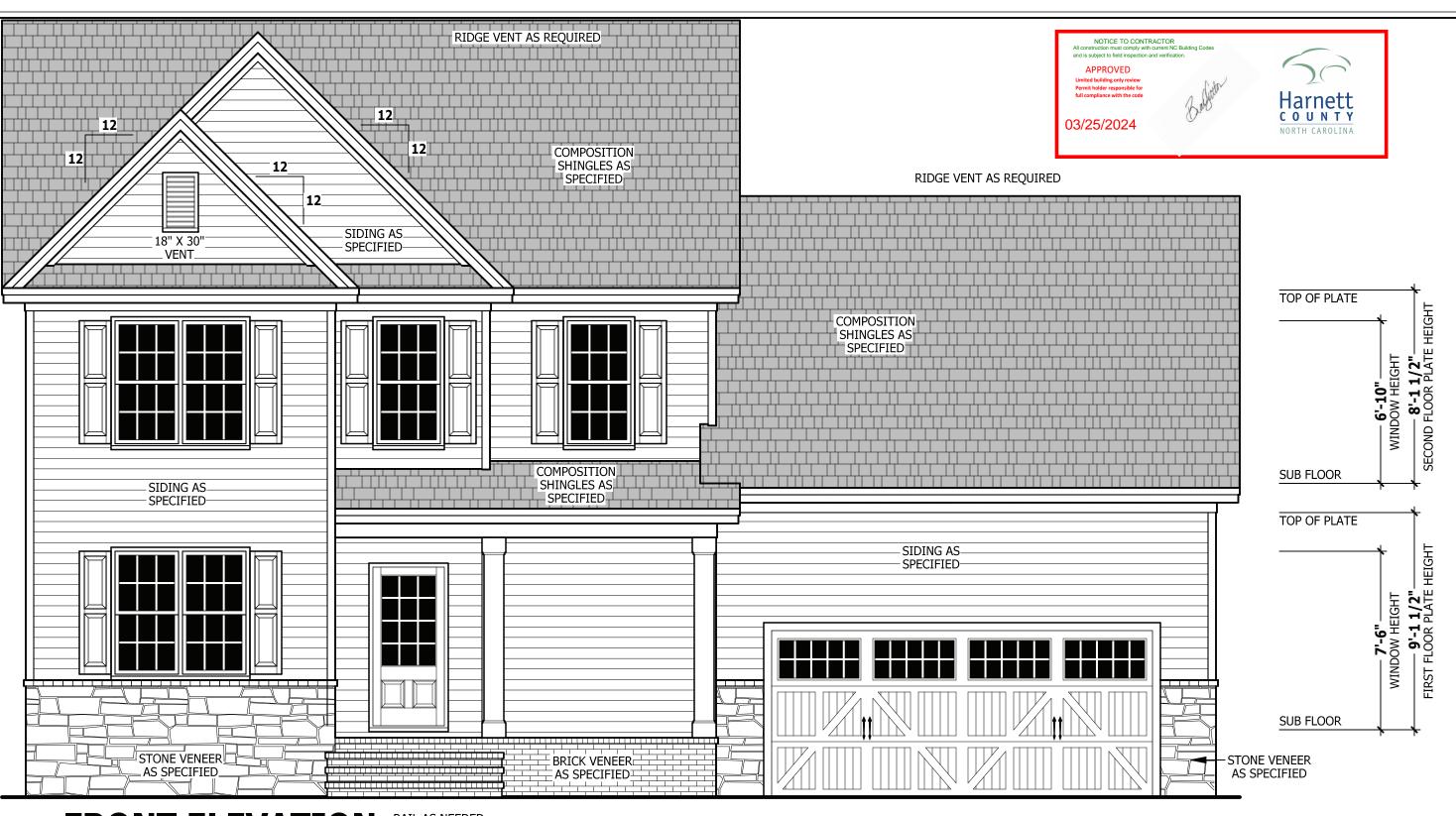

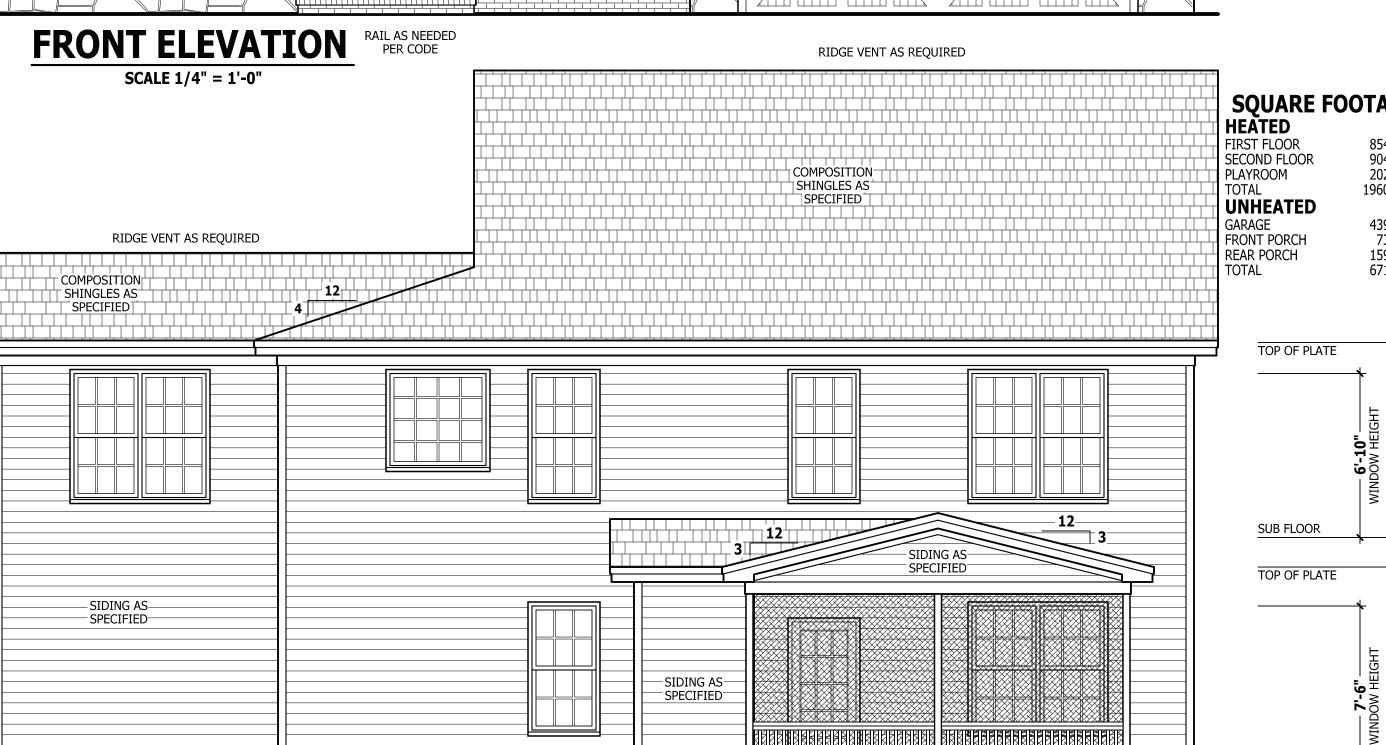
**N1102.4.1 Building thermal envelope.** The building thermal envelope shall be durably sealed with an air barrier system to limit infiltration. The sealing methods between dissimilar materials shall allow for differential expansion and contraction. For all homes, where present, the following shall be caulked, gasketed, weather stripped or otherwise sealed with an air barrier material or solid material consistent with Appendix E-2.4 of this code:

- 1. Blocking and sealing floor/ceiling systems and under knee walls
- open to unconditioned or exterior space.
- 2. Capping and sealing shafts or chases, including flue shafts. 3. Capping and sealing soffit or dropped ceiling areas.

Any variation with these drawings must be brought to Haynes Home Plan, Inc. attention before construction begins. **KNEE WALL AND CEILING HEIGHTS.** All finished knee wall heights and ceiling heights are shown furred down 10" from roof decking for insulation. If for any reason the truss manufacturer fails to meet or exceed designated heel heights, finished knee wall heights, or finished ceiling heights shown on these drawings the finished square footage may vary. Any discrepancy must be brought to Haynes Home Plans, Inc. attention, so a suitable solution can be reached before construction begins. Any variation due to these conditions not being met is the reasonability of the truss manufacturer.

**ANCHORAGE.** All required anchors for trusses due to uplift or bearing shall meet the requirements as specified on the truss schematics. **BEARING.** All trusses shall be designed for bearing on SPF #2 plates or ledgers unless noted otherwise.

**Plate Heights & Floor Systems.** See elevation page(s) for plate heights and floor system thicknesses.

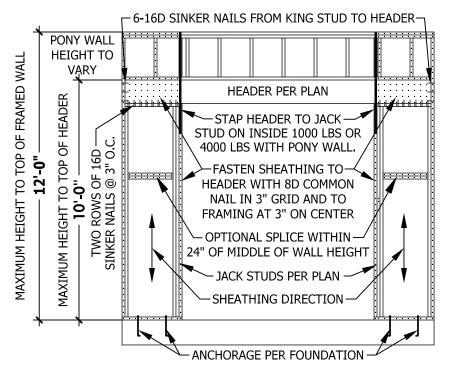

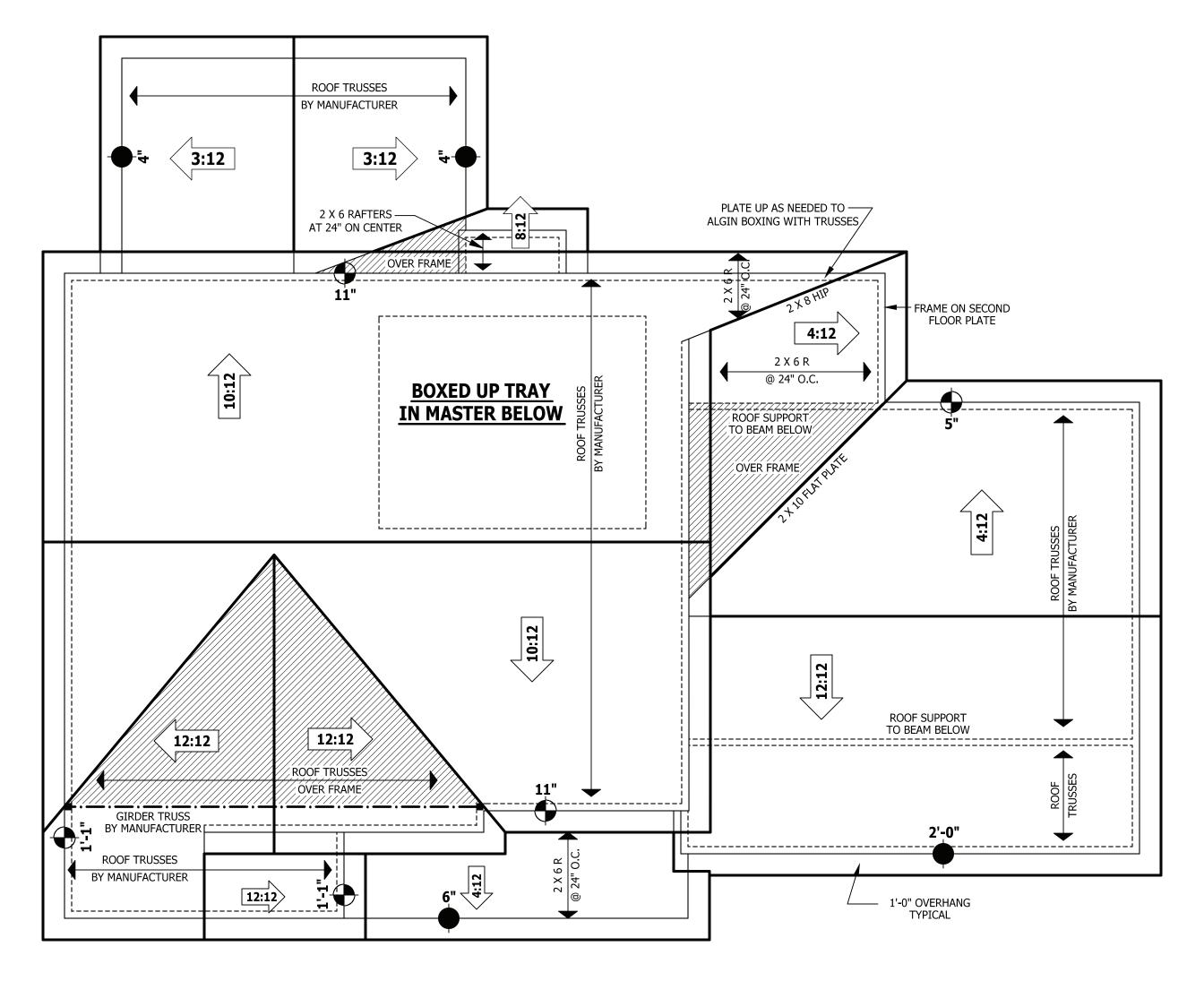

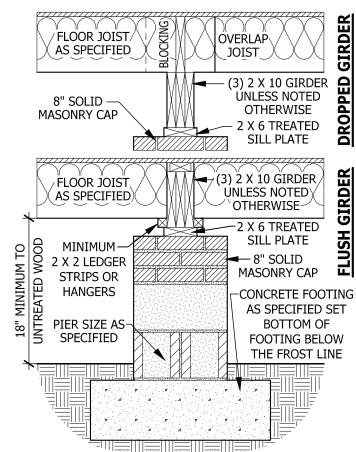
## **CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS**

### SECTION R315

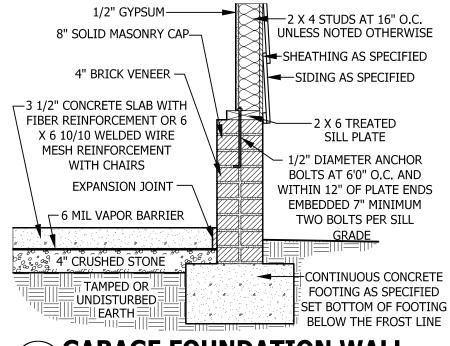
R315.1 Carbon monoxide alarms. In new construction, dwelling units shall be provided with an approved carbon monoxide alarm installed outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedroom(s) as directed by the alarm manufacturer.

**R315.2 Where required in existing dwellings.** In existing dwellings, where interior alterations, repairs, fuel-fired appliance replacements, or additions requiring a permit occurs, or where one or more sleeping rooms are added or created, carbon monoxide alarms shall be provided in accordance with Section

**R315.3 Alarm requirements.** The required carbon monoxide alarms shall be audible in all bedrooms over background noise levels with all intervening doors closed. Single station carbon monoxide alarms shall be listed as complying with UL 2034 and shall be installed in accordance with this code and the manufacturer's installation instructions.

# **SMOKE ALARMS**

R314.1 Smoke detection and notification. All smoke alarms shall be listed in accordance with UL 217 and installed in accordance with the provisions of this code and the household fire warning equipment provisions of NFPA 72. R314.2 Smoke detection systems. Household fire alarm systems installed in accordance with NFPA 72 that include smoke alarms, or a combination of smoke detector and audible notification device installed as required by this section for smoke alarms, shall be permitted. The household fire alarm system shall provide the same level of smoke detection and alarm as required by this section for smoke alarms. Where a household fire warning system is installed using a combination of smoke detector and audible notification device(s), it shall become a permanent fixture of the occupancy and owned by the homeowner. The system shall be monitored by an approved supervising station and be maintained in accordance with NFPA 72. **Exception:** Where smoke alarms are provided meeting the requirements of

**R314.3 Location.** Smoke alarms shall be installed in the following locations: 1. In each sleeping room. 2. Outside each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the

3. On each additional *story* of the *dwelling*, including *basements* and habitable attics (finished) but not including crawl spaces, uninhabitable (unfinished) attics and uninhabitable (unfinished) attic-stories. In dwellings or dwelling units with split levels and without an intervening door between the adjacent levels, a smoke alarm installed on the upper level shall suffice for the adjacent lower level provided that the lower level is less than one full story below the upper level.

When more than one smoke alarm is required to be installed within an individual *dwelling* unit the alarm devices shall be interconnected in such a manner that the actuation of one alarm will activate all of the alarms in the individual unit.

**R314.4 Power source.** Smoke alarms shall receive their primary power from the building wiring when such wiring is served from a commercial source, and when primary power is interrupted, shall receive power from a battery. Wiring shall be permanent and without a disconnecting switch other than those required for overcurrent protection. Smoke alarms shall be interconnected.

## **EXTERIOR WINDOWS AND DOORS**

R612.1 General. This section prescribes performance and construction requirements for exterior windows and doors installed in walls. Windows and doors shall be installed and flashed in accordance with the fenestration manufacturer's written installation instructions. Window and door openings shall be flashed in accordance with Section R703.8. Written installation instructions shall be provided by the fenestration manufacturer for each window

**R612.2 Window sills.** In *dwelling* units, where the opening of an operable window is located more than 72 inches (1829 mm) above the finished *grade* or surface below, the lowest part of the clear opening of the window shall be a minimum of 24 inches (610 mm) above the finished floor of the room in which the window is located. Operable sections of windows shall not permit openings that allow passage of a 4 inch (102 mm) diameter sphere where such openings are located within 24 inches (610 mm) of the finished floor. **Exceptions:** 

1. Windows whose openings will not allow a 4-inch diameter (102 mm) sphere to pass through the opening when the opening is in its largest opened position.

2. Openings that are provided with window fall prevention devices that comply with Section

3. Openings that are provided with fall prevention devices that comply with ASTM F 2090. 4. Windows that are provided with opening limiting devices that comply with Section R612.4. R612.3 Window fall prevention devices. Window fall prevention devices and window guards, where provided, shall comply with the requirements of ASTM F 2090.

## **DWELLING / GARAGE SEPARATION**

**REFER TO SECTIONS R302.5, R302.6, AND R302.7** 

WALLS. A minimum 1/2" gypsum board must be installed on all walls supporting floor/ceiling assemblies used for separation required by this section. **STAIRS.** A minimum of 1/2" gypsum board must be installed on the underside and exposed sides of all stairways.

**CEILINGS.** A minimum of 1/2" gypsum must be installed on the garage ceiling if there are no habitable room above the garage. If there are habitable room above the garage a minimum of 5/8" type X gypsum board must be installed on the garage ceiling. **OPENING PENETRATIONS.** Openings between the garage and residence shall be equipped with solid wood doors not less than 1 3/8 inches (35 mm) in thickness, solid or honeycomb core steel doors not less than 1 3/8 inches (35 mm) thick, or 20-minute

**DUCT PENETRATIONS.** Ducts in the garage and ducts penetrating the walls or ceilings separating the  $\mathit{dwelling}$  from the garage shall be constructed of a minimum No. 26 gage (0.48 mm) sheet steel or other *approved* material and shall have no openings

**OTHER PENETRATIONS.** Penetrations through the separation required in Section R302.6 shall be protected as required by Section R302.11, Item 4.

# **STAIRWAY NOTES**

R311.7.2 Headroom. The minimum headroom in all parts of the stairway shall not be less than 6 feet 8 inches (2032 mm) measured vertically from the sloped line adjoining the tread nosing or from the floor surface of the landing or platform on that portion of the stairway.

R311.7.4 Stair treads and risers. Stair treads and risers shall meet the requirements of this section. For the purposes of this section all dimensions and dimensioned surfaces shall be exclusive of carpets,

**R311.7.4.1 Riser height.** The maximum riser height shall be 8 1/4 inches (210 mm). The riser shall be measured vertically between leading edges of the adjacent treads.

**R311.7.4.2 Tread depth.** The minimum tread depth shall be 9 inches (229 mm). The tread depth shall be measured horizontally between the vertical planes of the foremost projection of adjacent treads and at a right angle to the tread's leading edge. Winder treads shall have a minimum tread depth of 9 inches (229 mm) measured as above at a point 12 inches (305 mm) from the side where the treads are narrower. Winder treads shall have a

minimum tread depth of 4 inches (102 mm) at any point. **R311.7.4.3 Profile.** The radius of curvature at the nosing shall be no greater than 9/16 inch (14 mm). A nosing not less than 3/4 inch (19 mm) but not more than 1 1/4 inches (32 mm) shall be provided on stairways with solid risers.

R311.7.7 Handrails. Handrails shall be provided on at least one side of each continuous run of treads or flight with four or more risers. **R311.7.7.1 Height.** Handrail height, measured vertically from the sloped plane adjoining the tread nosing, or finish surface of ramp slope, shall be not less than 34 inches (864 mm)and not more than 38 inches (965 mm). Exceptions:

1. The use of a volute, turnout or starting easing shall be allowed over the lowest tread.

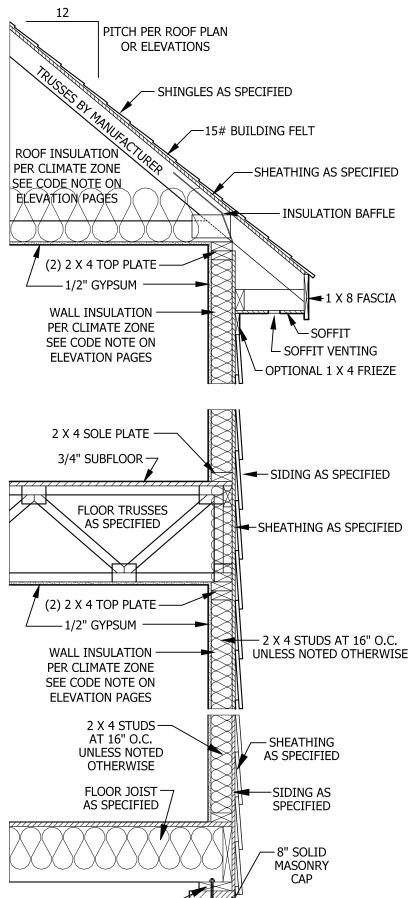
2. When handrail fittings or bendings are used to provide continuous transition between flights, the transition from handrail to guardrail, or used at the start of a flight, the handrail height at the fittings or bendings shall be permitted to exceed the maximum

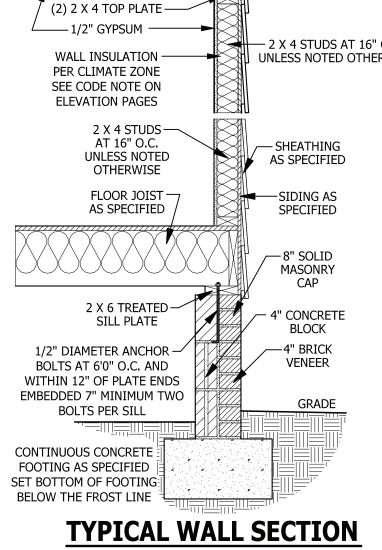
**R311.7.7.2 Continuity.** Handrails for stairways shall be continuous for the full length of the flight, from a point directly above the top riser of the flight to a point directly above the lowest riser of the flight. Handrail ends shall be returned or shall terminate in newel posts or safety terminals. Handrails adjacent to a wall shall have a space of not less than 11/2 inch (38 mm) between the wall and the handrails.

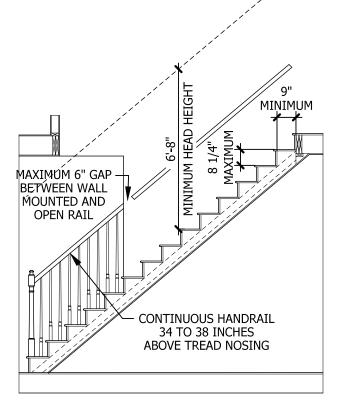
### Exceptions

1. Handrails shall be permitted to be interrupted by a newel post. 2. The use of a volute, turnout, starting easing or starting newel shall be allowed over the lowest tread.
