Dear Mr. Alvarez:

I am writing to address an issue raised by the Harnett County inspector during a rough-in inspection conducted on April 8, 2025. My findings are outlined below.

The inspector indicated a compaction test was required for the material placed behind the masonry foundation wall at the right front corner of the structure where the front porch slab will be constructed later. At the time of the inspection the exposed face of the masonry block wall was approximately 6'-0" in height. Fill material was subsequently placed on the outside face which reduces the effective height of the wall to approximately 4'-0". The area behind the wall was filled with #57/67 NCDOT stone and the cells of the masonry wall were filled with grout. The use of stone behind the wall allows the stone fill to drain and prevents water from collecting behind the wall which would exert lateral hydraulic pressure on the wall. In my professional opinion a compaction test would not yield useful information in this situation. I find the wall construction to be structurally acceptable with no modification or addition.
