A representative of JDS Consulting arrived on site to observe the issues reported to us by the client, which are presented, along with our recommendations, in this report.

## **Observations**

The client requested an evaluation of a damaged first-floor (F1-33) floor truss in the garage. The first vertical member between joints 16 and 17 has been displaced approximately 1" to the rear and left and pulled from the gusset plates.

## Recommendations

Based on our evaluation and review, the client shall:

- 1. Remove the damaged vertical members (two 2x4)
- 2. Replace the vertical members with new 2x4s cut to size and toenailed into the top and bottom chords with (2) 10d nails
- 3. Install a 12"x12"x7/16" OSB gusset on the back side of the truss, attached around the perimeter with (1) row of 6d nails at 4" o.c.
