SECOND FLOOR PLAN



STAGGERED AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION R703.8.2.1 OF THE NCRC, 2018 EDITION.
- 13. FOR STICK FRAMED ROOFS: CIRCLES DENOTE (3) 2 x 4 POSTS FOR ROOF MEMBER SUPPORT. HIP SPLICES ARE TO BE SPACED A MINIMUM OF 8'-0". FASTEN MEMBERS WITH THREE ROWS OF 12d NAILS AT 16" O.C. FRAME DORMER WALLS ON TOP OF DOUBLE OR TRIPLE RAFTERS AS SHOWN (UNO).
