





SECOND FLOOR FRAMING PLAN

ALL LOAD BEARING HEADERS TO CONFORM TO TABLE R602.7(1) AND R602.7(2) OF THE NCRC, 2018 EDITION OR BE (2) 2 x 6 WITH (1) JACK AND (1) KING STUD EACH END (UNO), WHICHEVER IS GREATER ALL HEADERS TO BE SECURED TO EACH JACK STUD WITH (4) 8d NAILS. ALL BEAMS TO BE SUPPORTED WITH (2) STUDS AT EACH BEARING POINT (UNO). INSTALL KING STUDS PER SECTION R602.7.5 OF THE NORTH CAROLINA RESIDENTIAL CODE, 2018 EDITION.
- 7. ALL BEAMS, HEADERS, OR GIRDER TRUSSES PARALLEL TO WALL ARE TO BEAR FULLY ON (1) JACK OR (2) STUDS MINIMUM OR THE NUMBER OF JACKS OR STUDS NOTED. ALL BEAMS OR GIRDER TRUSSES PERPENDICULAR TO WALL AND SUPPORTED BY (3) STUDS OR LESS ARE TO HAVE 1 1/2" MINIMUM BEARING (UNO). ALL BEAMS OR GIRDER TRUSSES PERPENDICULAR TO WALL AND SUPPORTED BY MORE THAN (3) STUDS OR OTHER NOTED COLUMN ARE TO BEAR FULLY ON SUPPORT COLUMN FOR ENTIRE WALL DEPTH (UNO). - 11. PROVIDE DOUBLE JOIST UNDER ALL WALLS PARALLEL TO FLOOR JOISTS. PROVIDE SUPPORT UNDER ALL WALLS PARALLEL TO FLOOR TRUSSES OR I—JOISTS PER MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS. INSTALL BLOCKING BETWEEN JOISTS OR TRUSSES FOR POINT LOAD SUPPORT FOR ALL POINT LOADS ALONG OFFSET LOAD LINES.
- 12. FOR ALL HEADERS SUPPORTING BRICK VENEER THAT ARE LESS THAN 8'-0" IN LENGTH, REST A 6" x 4" x 5/16" STEEL ANGLE WITH 6" MINIMUM EMBEDMENT AT SIDES FOR BRICK SUPPORT (U.N.O). FOR ALL HEADERS 8'-0" AND GREATER IN LENGTH, BOLT A 6" x 4" x 5/16" STEEL ANGLE TO HEADER WITH 1/2" LAG SCREWS AT 12" O.C. STAGGERED FOR BRICK SUPPORT. FOR ALL BRICK SUPPORT AT ROOF LINES, BOLT A 6" x 4" x 5/16" STEEL ANGLE TO (2) 2 x 10 BLOCKING INSTALLED w/ (4) 12d NAILS EA. PLY BETWEEN WALL STUDS WITH (2) ROWS OF 1/2" LAG SCREWS AT 12" O.C. STAGGERED AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION R703.8.2.1 OF THE NCRC, 2018 EDITION.
- 13. FOR STICK FRAMED ROOFS: CIRCLES DENOTE (3) 2 x 4 POSTS FOR ROOF MEMBER SUPPORT. HIP SPLICES ARE TO BE SPACED A MINIMUM OF 8'-0". FASTEN MEMBERS WITH THREE ROWS OF 12d NAILS AT 16" O.C. FRAME DORMER WALLS ON TOP OF DOUBLE OR TRIPLE RAFTERS AS SHOWN (UNO).
- 14. FOR TRUSSED ROOFS: FRAME DORMER WALLS ON TOP OF 2 x 4 LADDER FRAMING AT 24" O.C. BETWEEN ADJACENT ROOF TRUSSES. STICK FRAME OVER-FRAMED ROOF SECTIONS WITH 2 x 8 RIDGES, 2 x 6 RAFTERS AT 16" O.C. AND FLAT 2 x 10 VALLEYS (UNO).
- 15. ALL 4 x 4 AND 6 x 6 POSTS TO BE INSTALLED WITH 700 LB CAPACITY UPLIFT CONNECTORS TOP AND BOTTOM (UNO.) POSTS MAY BE SECURED USING ONE SIMPSON H6 OR LTS12 UPLIFT CONNECTOR FASTENED TO THE BAND AT THE BOTTOM AND THE BEAM AT THE TOP OF EACH POST. ONE 16" SECTION OF SIMPSON CS16 COIL STRAPPING WITH (8) 8d HDG NAILS AT EACH END MAY BE USED IN LIEU OF EACH TWIST STRAP IF DESIRED. FOR MASONRY OR CONCRETE FOUNDATION USE SIMPSON POST BASE.
