Hi Brad,

I hope all is well. Sorry it has taken me so long to get back with you. I was finally able to get an electrician out to this location to test the current load on this circuit. I did confirm this is 240v on a 20 amp breaker. Each leg was tested with the timer to the pole lights switched on and each leg was putting out 4.7 amps.

I confirmed the sign will need 3 amps and that will put us under 8 amps total on a 20 amp breaker.

Here are the answers to your questions.

- Is the light pole on the same property under the same ownership as the building, and the sign will be on the same property? YES
- Is the light pole fed from the building, or is it a power company maintained/leased pole that is NOT fed from the building? YES-Fed from building.
- What is the actual load and wire size of the circuit feeding the light pole (if not a power company lease pole). 240v at 4.7 amps

Please let me know if you need any additional information. I have included the electrician who I met with to confirm all of this information
