




> **ILLUSTRATIVE ELEVATION** (NTS)

CONSTRUCTION PRACTICES NOTES:

- 1. IF INTERRUPTION OF EXISTING UTILITY SERVICES IS UNAVOIDABLE, CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE MINIMUM OF 48 HOUR NOTICE TO OWNER OR REPRESENTATIVE PRIOR TO INTERRUPTION OF ANY EXISTING UTILITY SERVICE.
- THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR REPAIR AND/OR REPLACEMENT OF ANY UTILITIES DAMAGED DURING CONSTRUCTION AT HIS/HER OWN EXPENSE. CONTRACTOR IS TO MAINTAIN UTILITY SERVICES INCLUDING: WATER, SANITARY SEWER, STORM SEWER, NATURAL GAS, ELECTRIC AND TELEPHONE AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL KEEP ALL PARKING AREAS, ALLEYS, DRIVEWAYS, STREETS, ETC. ADJACENT TO THE CONSTRUCTION SITE CLEAN AT ALL TIMES DURING CONSTRUCTION. CONTRACTOR SHALL ENSURE WORK AREA IS CLEAN AND CLEAR OF ALL DEBRIS AND CONSTRUCTION WASTE AT CLOSE OF EACH BUSINESS DAY. NO TOOLS OR EQUIPMENT ARE TO BE LEFT OVERNIGHT WITHOUT EXPRESS PERMISSION OF OWNER. OWNER TAKES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO CONTRACTOR PROPERTY.
- 4. CONTRACTOR MUST TAKE STEPS TO PREVENT DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVEMENT OR EXCESSIVE TRACKING OF SOIL, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO LAYING ANTI-TRACKING MEASURES DOWN ON ALL ACTIVE DRIVES AND WORK AREAS. ANY EXCESS SOIL OR DEBRIS SPILLAGE MUST BE CLEANED SAME BUSINESS DAY. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBLE FOR REPLACING AND REPAIRING ANY EXISTING PAVEMENT AREAS DAMAGED DURING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY AT CONTRACTOR'S OWN EXPENSE.
- SIGNING OF THE CONSTRUCTION AREA SHALL COMPLY WITH THE CURRENT "FHWA MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES." ALL SIGNAGE INCLUDING REGULATORY AND WARNING SIGNS WHICH ARE OWNED AND MAINTAINED BY THE NCDOT ARE TO REMAIN THROUGHOUT THE DEMOLITION AND CONSTRUCTION PHASES. ALL SIGNS WHICH NEED TO BE REMOVED ARE TO BE RELOCATED IMMEDIATELY.
- REFER TO COMMUNITY CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS FOR COMMUNITY STORMWATER & EROSION CONTROL MEASURES, PLANS, AND PERMITS (BY OTHERS).

SAFETY AND ACCESS NOTES

- 4. CONTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL ALL STRUCTURES (INCLUDING ASSOCIATED FOOTERS) AND 1. THE CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO MEET ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, OSHA, STATE AND LOCAL PLANTINGS OUTSIDE OF SIGHT TRIANGLES, SIGHT DISTANCE LINES, AND UTILITY EASEMENTS. REGULATIONS CONCERNING PROJECT SAFETY AND ASSUMES RESPONSIBILITY FOR SAFETY ON THE PROJECT. 5. COLUMN LOCATIONS HAVE BEEN DIMENSIONED TO THE CENTER OF THE COLUMN.
- 2. CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE EVERY PRECAUTION TO PROTECT THE GENERAL PUBLIC FROM CONSTRUCTION AREAS FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO NON-WORKING HOURS.
- 3. NECESSARY BARRICADES, SUFFICIENT LIGHTS, SIGNS, AND OTHER TRAFFIC CONTROL METHODS AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE PROTECTION AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC SHALL BE PROVIDED AND MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE LIFE OF THE PROJECT. - 4. CONTRACTOR ACCESS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIRECTED BY OWNERS REPRESENTATIVE.
- 5. CONTRACTOR SHALL PREPARE A CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE AND VEHICULAR ACCESS SCHEDULE AND COORDINATE WITH NCDOT AND OWNER FOR TRAFFIC IMPACTS.



- LOCATION OF UTILITIES REPRESENTED ON THESE PLANS HAVE BEEN PROVIDED FOR INFORMATION PURPOSES. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR LOCATING UTILITIES (BOTH PUBLIC 2. ALL DETAILED STRUCTURAL, REINFORCEMENT, ELECTRICAL DESIGN, AND HARDWARE BY OTHERS. & PRIVATE) PRIOR TO START OF WORK ON THIS SITE. - 1. PLAN AND DETAILS SHOWN FOR DIMENSIONAL AND MATERIAL PURPOSES ONLY.
- VENEER, SIGN FACE, GROUT, MORTAR, LIGHTS, DECORATIVE HARDWARE, SOIL MIX, ETC., AND OBTAIN APPROVAL FROM OWNER AND LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION OR CONTRACTOR SHALL CREATE A MOCK-UP OF WALL, CAP, AND TRIM WITH DECORATIVE HARDWARE AND OBTAIN APPROVAL FROM OWNER OR LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION.









STREETSCAPE FENCE LAYOUT PLAN

- 1. CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY LAYOUT OF ENTRANCE MONUMENT AND FENCE. ENSURE NO CONFLICTS BETWEEN LOCATION AND FOOTINGS. CONTACT LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT WITH ANY CONCERNS PRIOR TO START OF CONSTRUCTION.
- 2. FENCE POSTS MADE WITH 6"x 6" PLANE FINISHED WESTERN RED CEDAR POST OR
- EQUALLY APPROVED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT AND OWNER. 3. FENCE BOARDS MADE WITH 4" x 2" X 10' P.T. CEDAR BOARD OR EQUALLY APPROVED
- BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT AND OWNER.



PLANTING NOTES: GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. ALL MATERIALS AND METHODS OF CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HARNETT COUNTY AND THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
- 2. ALL LANDSCAPE WORK SHALL BE PROVIDED BY OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED NC LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR.
- 3. LOCATIONS OF EXISTING UTILITY LINES SHOWN ON PLANS ARE BASED UPON BEST AVAILABLE INFORMATION AND CONSIDERED APPROXIMATE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOCATING ALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES IN AND ADJACENT TO THE WORK AREAS PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF WORK. ALL UTILITY LINES SHALL BE PROTECTED DURING THE CONSTRUCTION TO AVOID DAMAGE. HAND EXCAVATE AS REQUIRED THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REPAIRING ANY AND ALL UTILITIES, STRUCTURES, SITE APPURTENANCES, ETC. DAMAGED DURING CONSTRUCTION OR INSTALLATION OF PLANT MATERIAL AT CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
- 4. THE LOCATION OF ALL EXISTING UTILITIES SHALL BE CONFIRMED PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION. CALL "NC ONE-CALL", 1-800-632-4949. THE OWNER SHALL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY DISCREPANCIES BETWEEN FIELD CONDITIONS AND THOSE SHOWN ON THE PLAN.
- 5. ALL DIMENSIONS AND ELEVATIONS SHALL BE VERIFIED IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. ANY DISCREPANCIES SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT.
- 6. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH AND INSTALL ALL PLANT MATERIALS, LABOR AND OTHER MATERIALS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS AND DETAILS.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING ALL QUANTITIES SHOWN IN THE PLANT SCHEDULE AND MATCH QUANTITIES ON THE PLANS PRIOR TO PRICING WORK. SHOULD DISCREPANCIES OCCUR, THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT SHALL BE NOTIFIED PRIOR TO BIDDING.
- 8. ALL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL MEET MINIMUM SIZE STANDARDS, INCLUDING THE MINIMUM HEIGHT, WIDTH, ROOT BALL SIZE AND NUMBER OF BRANCHES, SET FORTH IN THE LATEST EDITION OF THE "AMERICAN STANDARD FOR NURSERY STOCK" PUBLISHED BY THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF NURSERYMEN (AAN) FOR THE TYPE OF TREE OR SHRUB AT THE TIME OF INSTALLATION.
- 9. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE NURSERY GROWN UNDER THE SAME CLIMATE CONDITIONS AS THE LOCATION OF THE PROJECT FOR AT LEAST TWO YEARS BEFORE PLANTING. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOOD HORTICULTURAL PRACTICES, HEALTHY, VIGOROUS, AND FREE OF INSECTS, EGGS, LARVAE, DISEASES AND DEFECTS SUCH AS KNOTS, SUN-SCALD, INJURIES, ABRASIONS OR DISFIGUREMENT. PLANT MATERIAL COLLECTED FROM NATURALIZED AREAS SHALL BE REJECTED.
- 10. SUBSTITUTIONS IN PLANT SPECIES OR SIZE SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED EXCEPT WITH THE WRITTEN APPROVAL OF THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT.
- 11. CALIPER, HEIGHT AND WIDTH SPECIFICATIONS INDICATED ON THE PLANT SCHEDULE SHALL TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER CONTAINER SIZE.
- 12. PLANT SIZES SHOWN IN THE PLANT SCHEDULE ARE THE MINIMUM SIZES BEFORE PRUNING. ANY NECESSARY PRUNING APPROVED BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT SHALL BE PERFORMED AT THE TIME OF PLANTING IF NEEDED. TREES AND SHRUBS OF LARGER SIZE MAY BE INSTALLED IF SIZES OF THE ROOTS OR BALLS ARE INCREASED PROPORTIONATELY.
- THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR INSTALLING PLANTS TO MEET THE MINIMUM SIZE AND SPACING FOR CODE COMPLIANCE. FAILURE TO INSTALL THE PLANT MATERIAL PER THE PLAN AND PLANT SCHEDULE MAY JEOPARDIZE ISSUANCE OF FINAL CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR SCHEDULING INSPECTIONS OF PLANT MATERIAL.
- 14. ALL SHADE/CANOPY/STREET TREES SHALL BE GRADE 'A' SPECIMENS WITH A STRAIGHT MAIN LEADER AND FULL HEAD. 15. ALL TREES OF THE SAME VARIETY SHALL MATCH IN SHAPE AND SIZE WHEN INSTALLED AS GROUPS, ROWS OR STREET TREES.
- 16. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE BALLED AND BURLAPPED OR CONTAINER GROWN AS INDICATED IN THE PLANT SCHEDULE. 17. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER
- INSTALLATION FOR COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS FOR NAME, VARIETY, SIZE, QUALITY AND INSTALLATION. 18. AREAS DAMAGED BY ACTIVITIES OF THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESEEDED/REPLANTED AND REPAIRED AT
- NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE OWNER. 19. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE TREES PROTECTION FENCING PER THE PLANS AND TREE PROTECTION FENCE DETAIL TO
- PROTECT ANY EXISTING TREES, SHRUBBERY AND PLANTING BEDS IN THE PLANTING AREA. 20. CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN AUTHORIZATION PRIOR TO ANY CHANGES OF PLANT LOCATIONS DUE TO UTILITIES OR OTHER CONFLICTS.
- 21. ALL STRUCTURES, WALLS, PIERS AND PLANT BED LOCATIONS SHALL BE FIELD STAKED BY THE CONTRACTOR AND LOCATION APPROVED BY THE OWNER PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION/ INSTALLATION.
- 22. NO WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY UNLESS ALL REQUIRED PERMITS ARE OBTAINED.




